

SIXTH AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF SAN MATEO AND VOICES OF RECOVERY SAN MATEO COUNTY

THIS SIXTH AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT, entered into this _____ day of _____, 2023, by and between the COUNTY OF SAN MATEO, hereinafter called "County," and Voices Of Recovery San Mateo County, hereinafter called "Contractor";

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, pursuant to Government Code, Section 31000, County may contract with independent contractors for the furnishing of such services to or for County or any Department thereof;

WHEREAS, the parties entered into an Agreement on September 15, 2020 for consumer-operated self-help and peer-support services, peer recovery supports and community integration, and wellness and recovery services for the term of July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2022, in an amount not to exceed \$829,134; and

WHEREAS, on December 21, 2020, the Chief of San Mateo County Health approved an amendment to add technology supports for clients and family members that do not have the resources to purchase the technology they need to participate in telehealth services and online groups, increasing the amount of the agreement by \$7,395 to \$836,528, with no change to the agreement term; and

WHEREAS, on September 14, 2021, the Board approved a second amendment to extend the term of peer recovery supports and community integration through December 31, 2021, increasing the amount of the agreement by \$83,373 to an amount not to exceed \$919,901; and

WHEREAS, on July 22, 2022, the Chief of San Mateo County Health approved a third amendment to increase the maximum amount by \$349,740 for a total amount not to exceed \$1,269,641 and extend the term through June 30, 2023; and

WHEREAS, on October 31, 2022, the Chief of San Mateo County Health approved a fourth amendment to increase the maximum amount by \$3,700 for expenses related to Recovery Happens events, increasing it to \$5,822, for a total maximum amount not to exceed \$1,273,341; and

WHEREAS, on March 9, 2023, the Chief of San Mateo County Health approved a fifth amendment to increase the maximum amount by \$14,634 to add Youth and Adult Mental Health First Aid classes, for a total maximum amount not to exceed \$1,287,975; and

WHEREAS, the parties wish to amend the Agreement to add \$1,907 for expenses related to Recovery Happens events, increasing the maximum amount by \$268,924 for a total amount not to exceed \$1,556,899 and extend the term of the Agreement by nine months through March 31, 2024.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY AGREED BY THE PARTIES HERETO AS FOLLOWS:

1. Section 3. Payments of the agreement is amended to read as follows:

In consideration of the services provided by Contractor in accordance with all terms, conditions and specifications set forth herein and in Exhibit A6, County shall make payment to Contractor based on the rates and in the manner specified in Exhibit B6. County reserves the right to withhold payment if County determines that the quantity or quality of the work performed is unacceptable. In no event shall the County's total fiscal obligation under this Agreement exceed ONE MILLION FIVE HUNDRED FIFTY-SIX THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED NINETY-NINE DOLLARS (\$1,556,899).

2. Section 4. Term of the agreement is amended to read as follows:

Subject to compliance with all terms and conditions, the term of this Agreement shall be from July 1, 2020 through March 31, 2024.

3. Sections A – F remain the same.

4. All other terms and conditions of the agreement, as previously amended, between the County and Contractor shall remain in full force and effect.
