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RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PRESIDENT OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH DASHER TECHNOLOGIES, FOR TECHNOLOGY FOR THE NORTH COUNTY WELLNESS CENTER PROJECT, FOR A TERM OF ONE YEAR FROM MARCH 24, 2026 THROUGH MARCH 23, 2027, FOR A MAXIMUM FISCAL OBLIGATION OF \$329,194.50

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the North County Wellness Center (formerly referred to as the South San Francisco County Wellness Center), will be a 77,000 square foot, three-level facility that will provide numerous medical and human services, including express care, primary care, specialty care, dental care, optometry, and case management, to an underserved part of the County; and

WHEREAS, in addition to the Health System and Human Services Agency, the facility will include space for the District Attorney, Aging and Disability Services, and the Treasurer-Tax Collector; and

WHEREAS, network switches and wireless access points are necessary to provide uninterrupted connectivity and wireless access for departments operating within the North County Wellness Center and the services provided therein; and

WHEREAS, on October 14, 2025, the County released a Request for Proposals (RFP) for Arista & Aruba Network Gear, Software, Accessories, Aruba Wireless Access

Points, APC Uninterrupted Power Supplies and Power Distribution Equipment for the South San Francisco Wellness Center Project; and

WHEREAS, on November 4, 2025, the County received eight proposals and following review by an inter-departmental panel selected the lowest responsive bidder, Dasher Technologies, to enter into an agreement with the County.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the Board of Supervisors adopt a resolution authorizing and directing the President of the Board of Supervisors to execute an agreement with Dasher Technologies for technology for the North County Wellness Center project in an amount not to exceed \$329,194.50.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of Public Works, or designee, is authorized to execute contract amendments to the agreement modifying the terms and conditions, including but not limited to the purchase of additional components needed up to an amount not to exceed \$25,000 for a maximum fiscal obligation of \$354,194.50.

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
