FOURTH AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF SAN MATEO AND CHILD CARE COORDINATING COUNCIL OF SAN MATEO COUNTY

THIS FOURTH AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT, entered into this

date April 22, 25 by and between the COUNTY OF SAN MATEO, hereinafter called

"County," and Child Care Coordinating Council of San Mateo County, hereinafter called

"Contractor";

$\underline{W I T N E S S E T H}$:

WHEREAS, pursuant to Government Code, Section 31000, County may contract with independent contractors for the furnishing of such services to or for County or any Department thereof;

WHEREAS, on June 13, 2023, the parties entered into a subrecipient agreement (the "Agreement") for the term of July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024 and a total obligation amount of \$239,198 to administer child care subsidy payments and enroll eligible families under the CalWORKs Stage 2 program; and

WHEREAS, on November 11, 2023, the parties amended the Agreement ("First Amendment") to decrease the total obligation amount by \$7,657 for a new total obligation amount of \$231,541 with no change to the term, to align with the CalWORKs Stage 2 funding allocation amount received after the Agreement was executed; and

WHEREAS, on June 25, 2024 the parties further amended the Agreement ("Second Amendment") to extend the term by 12 months, for a new term of July 1, 2023 to June 30, 2025 and added funding in the amount of \$658,459 to cover the cost to continue providing services for the additional term; and

WHEREAS, on July 10, 2024, the parties further amended the Agreement ("Third Amendment") to add language to Exhibit B that allows the County to adjust funding across fiscal years to better align with CalWORKs Stage 2 funding allocations received, and with no change to the term or total obligation amount; and

WHEREAS, the parties wish to further amend the Agreement ("Fourth Amendment") to extend the term by 12 months, for a new term of July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2026, and increase funding by \$600,000, for a new obligation amount of \$1,490,000 to cover the cost to provide services for the additional term; and

WHEREAS, this Agreement is pursuant to:

- 1. CFDA # 93.575, Child Care and Development Fund
- 2. Federal DUNS: 831354883
- 3. FAIN: 2234CACCDF1901CCDF
- 4. Federal Award Period of Performance: July 01, 2024 through June 30, 2025
- 5. This is California's subsidized childcare and development programs such as voucherbased child care, and direct contracts through Title-IV Subsidized Child Care.

WHEREAS, County is hereby awarding the following Federal Funds:

- 1. Amount of Federal funds obligated by this action to sub-recipient: \$600,000
- 2. Indirect Cost Rate for Federal Award: 10%
- 3. This is not a Research and Development Award

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY AGREED BY THE PARTIES HERETO AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. **Paragraph 4. Payments** is hereby amended to reflect a total obligation amount of ONE MILLION FOUR HUNDRED-NINETY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,490,000).
- 2. **Paragraph 5. Term** is hereby amended to reflect a term of July 1, 2023 to June 30, 2026.
- 3. **Exhibit B** is hereby amended to include a budget for FY 2025-26 and is attached hereto.
- 4. All other terms and conditions of the Agreement dated June 13, 2023 and its subsequent First, Second and Third Amendments, between the County and Contractor shall remain in full force and effect.
