BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, COUNTY OF SAN MATEO, STATE OF CALIFORNIA

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RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH SURESCRIPTS, LLC TO PROVIDE E-PRESCRIBING, ELECTRONIC PRIOR AUTHORIZATION, AND REAL-TIME PRESCRIPTION BENEFITS FOR THE ELECTRONIC HEALTH RECORD WITHIN SAN MATEO COUNTY HEALTH FOR THE TERM OF MAY 21, 2024, THROUGH MAY 20, 2029, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$4,383,817

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, San Mateo County Health (SMCH) requires a new E-prescribing, Electronic Prior Authorization, and Real-Time Prescription Benefits system that was previously completed using systems that will be replaced by SMCH's new Electronic Health Records (EHR) system, Epic; and

WHEREAS, a Request for Proposals was issued for a E-prescribing, Electronic Prior Authorization, and Real-Time Prescription Benefits system and was designed to demonstrated integration experience for the transition to Epic, and Surescripts, LLC (Surescripts) was elevated; and

WHEREAS, Surescripts and SMCH wish to enter into an agreement to provide E-prescribing, Electronic Prior Authorization, and Real-Time Prescription Benefits that is fully integrated with Epic, in an amount not to exceed \$4,383,817, for the term of May 21, 2024 through May 20, 2029; and

WHEREAS, this Board has been presented with a form of the agreement and has

examined and approved it as to both form and content and desires to enter into it.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the President of this Board of Supervisors is hereby authorized and directed to execute said agreement for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, and the Clerk of this Board shall attest the President's signature thereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chief of San Mateo County Health or their designee is authorized to execute contract amendments which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in aggregate), and/or modify the contract term and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.

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
