# *Albert Frank Sandoval*

*For His Honorable Service to the United States and in Recognition of a  
Century of Life, Legacy, and Resilience*

**WHEREAS, Albert Frank Sandoval** was born on March 1, 1926, in Fort Sumner, New Mexico, a proud member of the Navajo Nation, and one of thirteen children raised in a family rooted in hard work, resilience, and perseverance; and

**WHEREAS,** from a young age, **Albert Frank Sandoval** demonstrated an extraordinary work ethic, laboring in the fields as early as five years old and taking on additional responsibilities in his youth to help support his family, laying the foundation for a lifetime of dedication and integrity; and

**WHEREAS,** during World War II, **Albert Frank Sandoval** answered the call to serve his country, enlisting in the United States Navy on July 19, 1943, and serving honorably until February 2, 1946, as a Radar Man Third Class and Coxswain in Standard Landing Craft Unit 24, including service aboard the USS Tuscaloosa; and

**WHEREAS, Albert Frank Sandoval** served with honor during World War II, contributing to critical operations in support of Allied efforts; and

**WHEREAS,** for his honorable and courageous service, **Albert Frank Sandoval** was awarded the World War II Victory Medal, the Philippine Liberation Medal with a bronze service star, and the Asiatic-Pacific Campaign Medal;

**WHEREAS,** following his military service, **Albert Frank Sandoval** built a life grounded in faith, love, and family, marrying Margaret Cobb and settling in San Bruno, California, where together they raised four children and created a home filled with warmth and strong values; and

**WHEREAS,** a cancer survivor and lifelong golfer, **Albert Frank Sandoval** embraced life with gratitude and determination, achieving personal milestones including a celebrated hole-in-one and traveling the world alongside his beloved wife; and

**WHEREAS,** today, **Albert Frank Sandoval** is the cherished patriarch of a large and loving family, whose legacy of perseverance, faith, service, and love continues to inspire generations.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, hereby recognizes and honors **Albert Frank Sandoval** for his military service and enduring legacy, and honors the remarkable milestone of 100 years of life, with gratitude and best wishes for his continued health and happiness.
