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RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH PRESIDIO NETWORKED SOLUTIONS GROUP, LLC FOR A CLOUD-BASED DISASTER RECOVERY AS A SERVICE PROVIDING COMPUTING CONTINUITY, FOR THE TERM OF MAY 21, 2024 TO MAY 20, 2027, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,635,289

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the County provides critical public services and disaster response during emergencies and disasters; and

WHEREAS, many County departments rely heavily on the availability of their

Virtual Machines (VMs) to provide services, and Disaster Recovery as a Service

(DRaaS) will significantly benefit departments that host their primary applications on

VMs by providing data protection and operational continuity; and

WHEREAS, the County requires a DRaaS solution to replicate servers to a

geographically diverse cloud-based site; and

WHEREAS, the Request for Proposals (RFP) process was used to solicit and

select Presidio Networked Solutions Group, LLC for such services as their proposal was

identified as the most suitable for the County; and

WHEREAS, the parties wish to execute an agreement between the County and Presidio Networked Solutions Group, LLC for a cloud-based Disaster Recovery as a

Service providing computing continuity, for the term of May 21, 2024 to May 20, 2027, in an amount not to exceed \$1,635,289; and

WHEREAS, this Board has been presented with the form of such agreement and has examined and approved it as to both form and content and desires to enter the agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the

President of the Board of Supervisors is hereby authorized and directed to execute said agreement for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, and the Clerk of the Board shall attest to the President's signature thereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chief Information Officer (CIO) or CIO's designee is authorized to execute contract amendments which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in aggregate), and/or modify the contract term and/or services so long as the modified term of services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.

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
