**BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, COUNTY OF SAN MATEO, STATE OF CALIFORNIA**

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**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH STARVISTA TO PROVIDE DIFFERENTIAL RESPONSE SERVICES FOR THE TERM OF DECEMBER 6, 2023 THROUGH DECEMBER 5, 2026 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$3,919,503**

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**RESOLVED**, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

**WHEREAS**, Differential Response (DR) is a prevention and early-intervention strategy provided to family units to reduce child abuse and neglect by providing for a holistic, flexible, and customized approach to reports of child abuse or neglect within identified response paths based on an assessment of safety and risk to determine the strengths and needs of the child and the child’s family; and

**WHEREAS**, on July 17, 2023, the Human Services Agency (HSA) released a Request for Proposals (RFP) to identify a DR provider and StarVista was selected based on the evaluation criteria scoring for organizational experience and capacity as well as quality assurance, performance, and outcomes; and

**WHEREAS**, under this agreement StarVista will provide early intervention services to include coaching and counseling to families using evidence-based parenting and family support models, and referring to and collaborating with community-based organizations (CBOs) to meet the family’s basic and other identified needs; and

**WHEREAS**, there has been presented to this Board of Supervisors for its consideration and acceptance an agreement with StarVista, reference to which is hereby made for further particulars, for an amount not to exceed \$3,919,503 for the term of December 6, 2023 through December 5, 2026.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED** that the President of this Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized and directed to execute said Agreement for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, and the Clerk of the Board shall attest the President's signature thereto.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Director of the Human Services Agency or designee is authorized to execute contract amendments which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in aggregate), and/or modify the contract term and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.

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
