**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXTRA-HELP HIRING OF PUBLIC SAFETY COMMUNICATIONS' RETIRING SUPERVISING COMMUNICATIONS DISPATCHER, DAVID VOGT, PURSUANT TO GOVERNMENT CODE §7522.56(f)(1), AND FINDING THAT THE NATURE OF EMPLOYMENT AND APPOINTMENT IS NECESSARY TO FILL A CRITICALLY-NEEDED POSITION DURING THE 180-DAY POST-RETIREMENT SEPARATION PERIOD**

**RESOLVED**, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

**WHEREAS**, David Vogt will retire August 7, 2021, after serving the County of San Mateo for more than 32 years, first as relief dispatcher while serving as a police officer for the cities of Half Moon Bay and San Mateo, then promoting to end his career as a Supervising Communications Dispatcher; and

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Vogt possesses credentials for Law, Fire, and Emergency Medical dispatching, as well as training and quality assurance skills, which are critical needs of the 9-1-1 Dispatch Center; and

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Vogt will be employed at the base rate of \$52.88 per hour, the current rate of pay for a Communications Dispatcher II-R (Extra Help) and would be limited to working a maximum of 960 hours each fiscal year; and

**WHEREAS**, Government Code §7522.56 requires a 180-day separation period as established by the California Public Employees' Pension Reform Act, before re-hiring

or contracting with a retired employee unless the entity's governing body makes a finding certifying that the appointment is necessary to fill a critically needed position.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED** that the Board of Supervisors certifies, pursuant to Government Code §7522.56(f)(1), the nature of the employment described above and that the requested appointment is necessary to fill a critically needed position in the Public Safety Communications Department before 180 days have passed given the facts outlined above, and accordingly approves the hiring of David Vogt, into an extra-help position upon his retirement.
