RESOLUTION HONORING AND COMMENDING

Dr. Lisa Chamberlain

for her Outstanding Service to the County of San Mateo as a

Child Health Advocate

WHEREAS, Dr. Lisa Chamberlain has served with distinction as a Professor of Pediatrics at Stanford University School of Medicine for nearly 30 years, demonstrating unwavering commitment to the health, education, and well-being of children, families, and communities; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Chamberlain received her medical education at the University of Arizona and began her work in the Bay Area as a pediatric resident at Stanford in 1996; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Chamberlain's leadership has been instrumental in centering advocacy, policy, and community engagement at the core of Stanford Medicine's mission, demonstrated by the founding and development of numerous innovative programs, including the first Community and Advocacy Rotations for medical students and pediatric residents and the Stanford Pediatric Advocacy Track "StAT" to train pediatricians to address child poverty; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Chamberlain co-founded the "California Collaborative" in 2007 which unites California's 14 pediatric training programs and continues today as an educational and advocacy group, training over 800 California pediatricians a year; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Chamberlain worked closely with families in East Palo Alto as a primary care pediatrician at the Ravenswood Family Health Center for 14 years, which inspired her to pursue a sabbatical at the Stanford Graduate School of Education to study the role of the health sector in addressing educational disparities; and

WHEREAS, as the Associate Director of the Center on Early Childhood, **Dr. Chamberlain** leads the Stanford evaluation of San Mateo County's Baby Bonus Program which examines the impact of community health workers and cash gifts for low-income families with children ages zero to three; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Chamberlain co-founded the Stanford Office of Child Health Equity (OCHE) which has engaged 68 faculty from 11 divisions and addresses food insecurity, transplant equity, school re-entry and pre-hospital care; and

WHEREAS, nationally, **Dr. Chamberlain** serves on the American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP) Child Health Financing, on the Board of Advisors of "Zero to Three", and is the recipient of many national and local awards; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Chamberlain will be returning to her home state and Alma Mater at the University of Arizona College of Medicine as the Chair of the Department of Pediatrics and Director of the Steele Research Institute, where she will share her talents as a dedicated leader, mentor, and advocate for the children of Arizona.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California hereby honors and commends **Dr. Lisa Chamberlain** for her contributions and dedication as a physician, visionary, and advocate for the San Mateo County community and wishes her the best in her next chapter.
