BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, COUNTY OF SAN MATEO, STATE OF CALIFORNIA

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RESOLUTION:

- A) ADOPTING PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, INCLUDING CONFORMANCE WITH FEDERAL PREVAILING WAGE SCALE REQUIREMENTS, FOR THE ENTRADA WAY SLIP-OUT REPAIR PROJECT; AND**
- B) AUTHORIZING THE PRESIDENT OF THE BOARD TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH GRANITE ROCK COMAPNY, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$2,263,406.50 FOR THE ENTRADA WAY SLIP-OUT REPAIR PROJECT; AND**
- C) AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS TO:**
- 1) EXECUTE SUBSEQUENT CHANGE ORDERS TO GRANT TIME EXTENSIONS FOR PROJECT COMPLETION AND PAYMENT UP TO A MAXIMUM AGGREGATE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$226,340.65, OR APPROXIMATELY 10 PERCENT OF THE AGREEMENT AMOUNT; AND**
- 2) EXECUTE PAYMENT UP TO THE NOT-TO-EXCEED AMOUNT OF \$2,489,747.15 FOR ITEMS REQUIRING ADJUSTMENT BASED ON UNIT BID PRICES WITHOUT EXECUTION OF A CHANGE ORDER**

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, Entrada Way is a County maintained road in the unincorporated La Honda area that serves as the primary access route for the La Honda community, emergency vehicles, and utility connections, all of which cross the La Honda Creek at the existing culvert; and

WHEREAS, the top of bank adjacent to the culvert and surrounding roadway prism have experienced significant damage and erosion as a result of the 2022-2023 winter storms; and

WHEREAS, the Entrada Way Slip-Out Repair Project (Project) will protect the roadway, reduce erosion and sediment delivery, improve stormwater conveyance and

local drainage along Entrada Way, enhance water quality by stabilizing the eroded culvert and creek bank, and improve fish passage and habitat in La Honda Creek; and

WHEREAS, this Board of Supervisors did, on June 13, 2023, adopt Resolution No. 079733, which approved the development of the Project resulting from 2022-2023 winter storm damage and authorized the Director of Public Works to develop plans, specifications, and call for bids for the Project; and

WHEREAS, this Board of Supervisors did, on June 9, 2026, adopt Resolution No. 081871, certifying the Final Initial Study / Mitigated Negative Declaration and the Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program, and concurrently, the Board adopted a Resolution of Necessity authorizing the eminent domain acquisition of certain easements needed for the project; and

WHEREAS, the Project plans and specifications, dated June 26, 2026, have been prepared and approved by the Director of the Department of Public Works for the Project, and said plans and specifications have been filed in the office of the Director (the “plans and specifications”); and

WHEREAS, the plans and specifications require that the contractors performing the work pay not less than the federal prevailing wages, as established by the Department of Industrial Relations, in the locality in which said work is to be performed for each type of worker needed to execute the contract; and

WHEREAS, the Department did issue a call for sealed proposals to be received at the office of the County Executive/Clerk of the Board of Supervisors, 500

County Center, Redwood City, California, until the hour of 2:00 p.m., on Thursday, July 23, 2026; and

WHEREAS, the Department did cause the notice inviting sealed proposals to be published three (3) times in the Examiner Peninsula Newspaper Group, a newspaper of general circulation printed and published in this County, and obtained an affidavit of said publication; and

WHEREAS, the Clerk of this Board of Supervisors did, in public on July 23, 2026, at 2:00 p.m., open and examine all sealed bids that were received in the specified time for the doing of the work referred to in said Plans and Specifications; and

WHEREAS, this Board of Supervisors has caused an analysis of said bids to be made by the Director, and has, in open session, fully reviewed and considered said sealed proposals and analysis thereof; and

WHEREAS, the lowest responsible bid received was submitted by Granite Rock Company, in the amount of \$2,263,406.50 based on an estimate of the amount of work to be done.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED as follows:

1. The Plans and Specifications dated June 26, 2026, for the aforesaid Project are hereby approved and are adopted as the Plans and Specifications to be adhered to in letting and performing the work under a contract for said improvements.

2. It is to the best interest of the County of San Mateo to award the agreement for the Entrada Way Slip-Out Repair Project to:

3. The County of San Mateo shall enter into a written agreement with Granite Rock Company, for the completion of said work as required by the Plans and Specifications adopted by this Board of Supervisors, as hereinbefore mentioned, which Plans and Specifications are on file in the office of the Director of Public Works of the County of San Mateo.
4. The President of this Board of Supervisors shall be, and is hereby, authorized and directed to execute an agreement with Granite Rock Company, for the doing of said work described therein, subject to the Department of Public Works' receipt and approval of the Faithful Performance Surety Bond ("Performance Bond") and the Labor and Material Surety Bond ("Payment Bond") required to be posted by said Contractor with the County of San Mateo in connection therewith, and the Clerk of the Board shall attest the President's signature thereto.
5. The Director of Public Works is hereby authorized to execute change orders related to said work for time extensions and payment not exceeding \$226,340.65 of bid in aggregate.
6. The Director of Public Works is hereby authorized to approve payments up to the not to exceed amount of \$2,489,747.15 for items requiring adjustment based on unit bid prices without execution of a change order.

7. All payments to the Contractor shall be in accordance with the Plans and Specifications, and other agreement documents. Aggregate payment to the Contractor shall not exceed \$2,489,747.15 without this Board's approval.
8. The Clerk of the Board of Supervisors, County of San Mateo, is hereby authorized and directed to attest the signature of the President of this Board of Supervisors to said written agreement.

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
