RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH HEALTHRIGHT 360 TO PROVIDE PRIMARY CARE SERVICES AT THE CORDILLERAS MEDICAL HEALTH AND REHABILITATION CENTER, FOR THE TERM OF JULY 1, 2021, THROUGH JUNE 30, 2024, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$750,000

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, Behavioral Health and Recovery Services (BHRS) operates Cordilleras Mental Health Center, which includes the Cordilleras Mental Health and Rehabilitation unit (Cordilleras), managed by Telecare Corporation, and

WHEREAS, since 2019, HealthRIGHT 360 has partnered with the County to provide primary care services for Cordilleras patients, and the parties wish to continue this partnership under a three-year agreement that adds certain additional support services to help facilitate referrals of Cordilleras patient for specialty services, and

WHEREAS, the County and HealthRIGHT 360 wish to enter into an agreement whereby HealthRIGHT 360 will provide primary care services for Cordilleras patients for the term of July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2024, for an amount not to exceed \$750,000; and

WHEREAS, this Board has been presented with a form of such agreement, has examined and approved it as both form and content, and desires to enter into it.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the President of the Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized and directed to execute said agreement for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, and the Clerk of the Board shall attest the President's signature thereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chief of San Mateo County Health or designee is authorized to execute contract amendments which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in aggregate) and/or modify the contract term and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.
