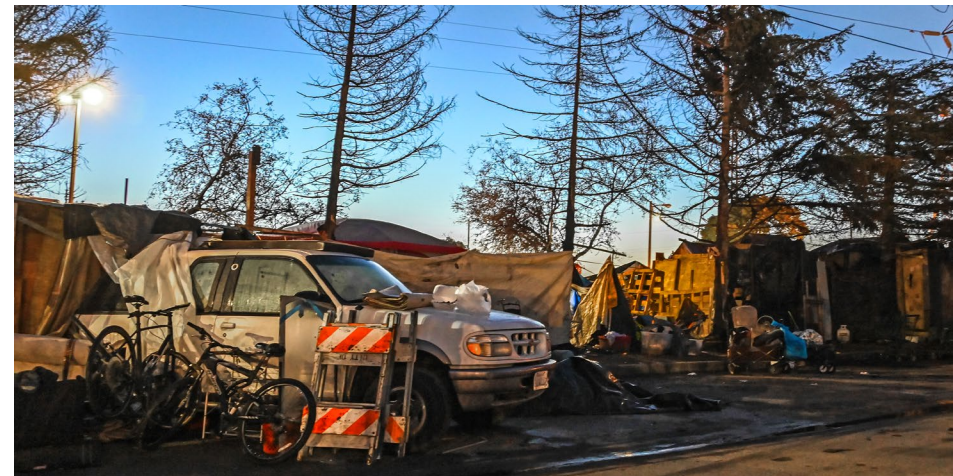

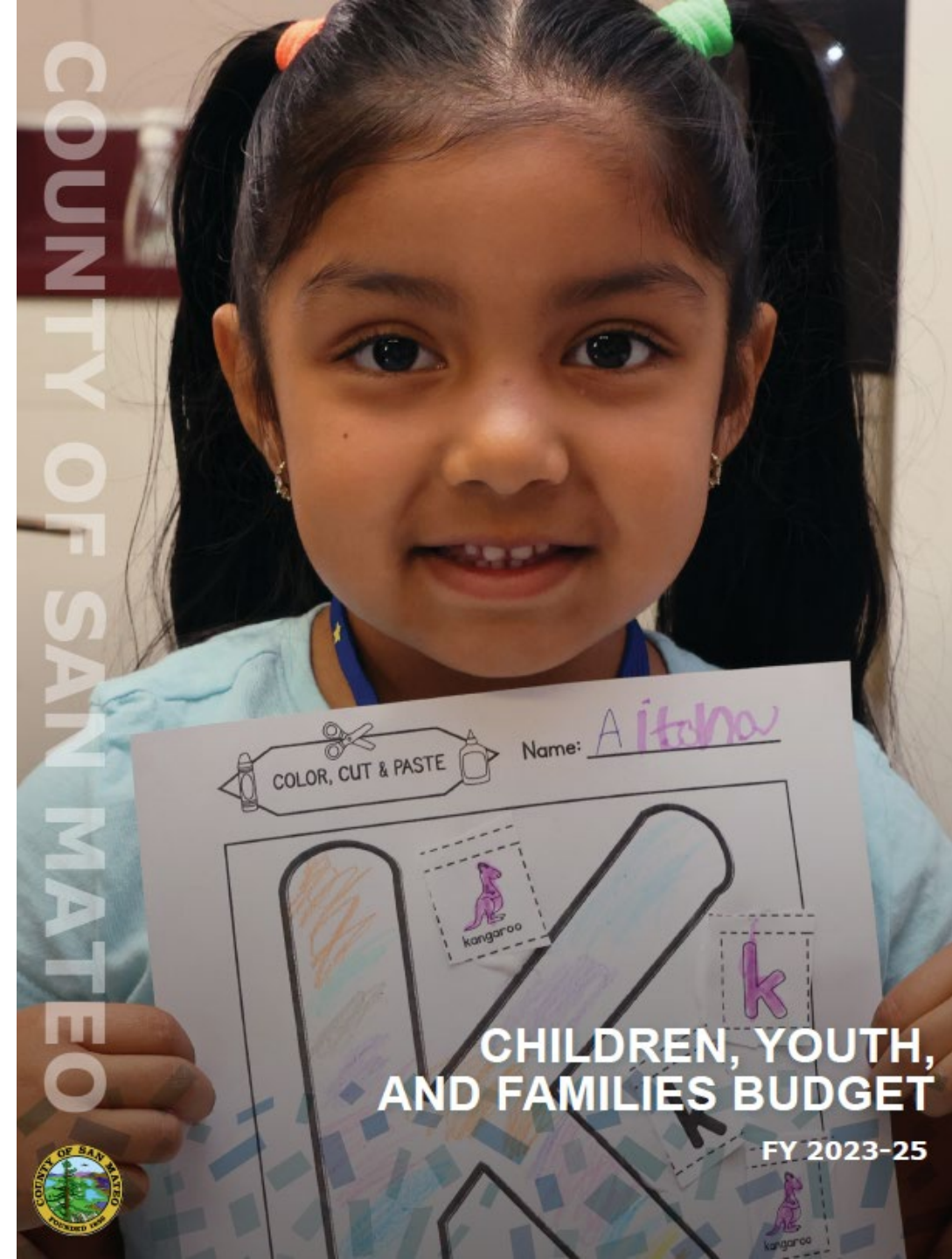

FY 2023-25 Children, Youth and Families Demographics

- 193,000 or 26.4% identified children and youth countywide.
 - 15.7% children and youth are living under California's poverty rate
 - 7.7% are living below the federal poverty rate
 - 58% of the children and youth have one or more immigrant parents
 - 9.1% are immigrant themselves
- SMC has 144 programs that provide direct safety net services to our children, youth and families. A few of them include:
 - San Mateo California Children's Services
 - Healthy Families San Mateo Program
 - CARON Program

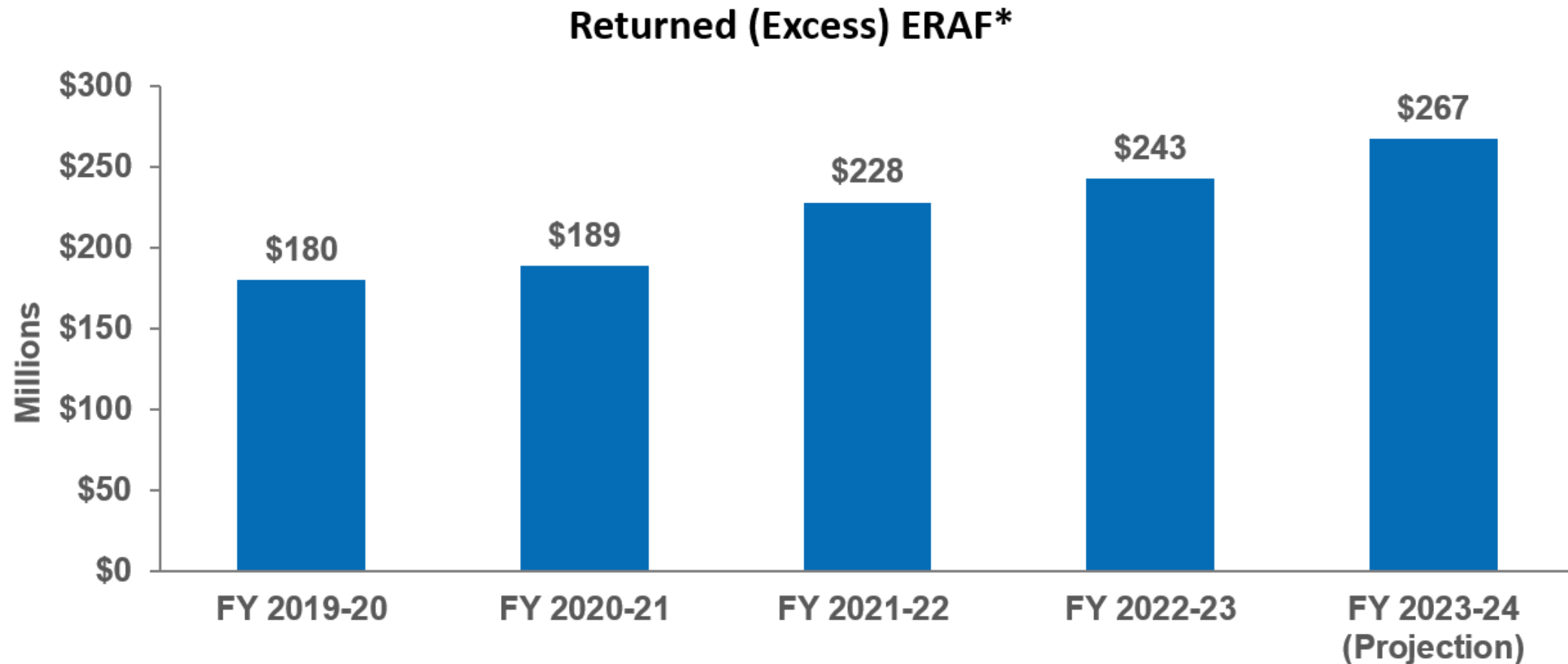

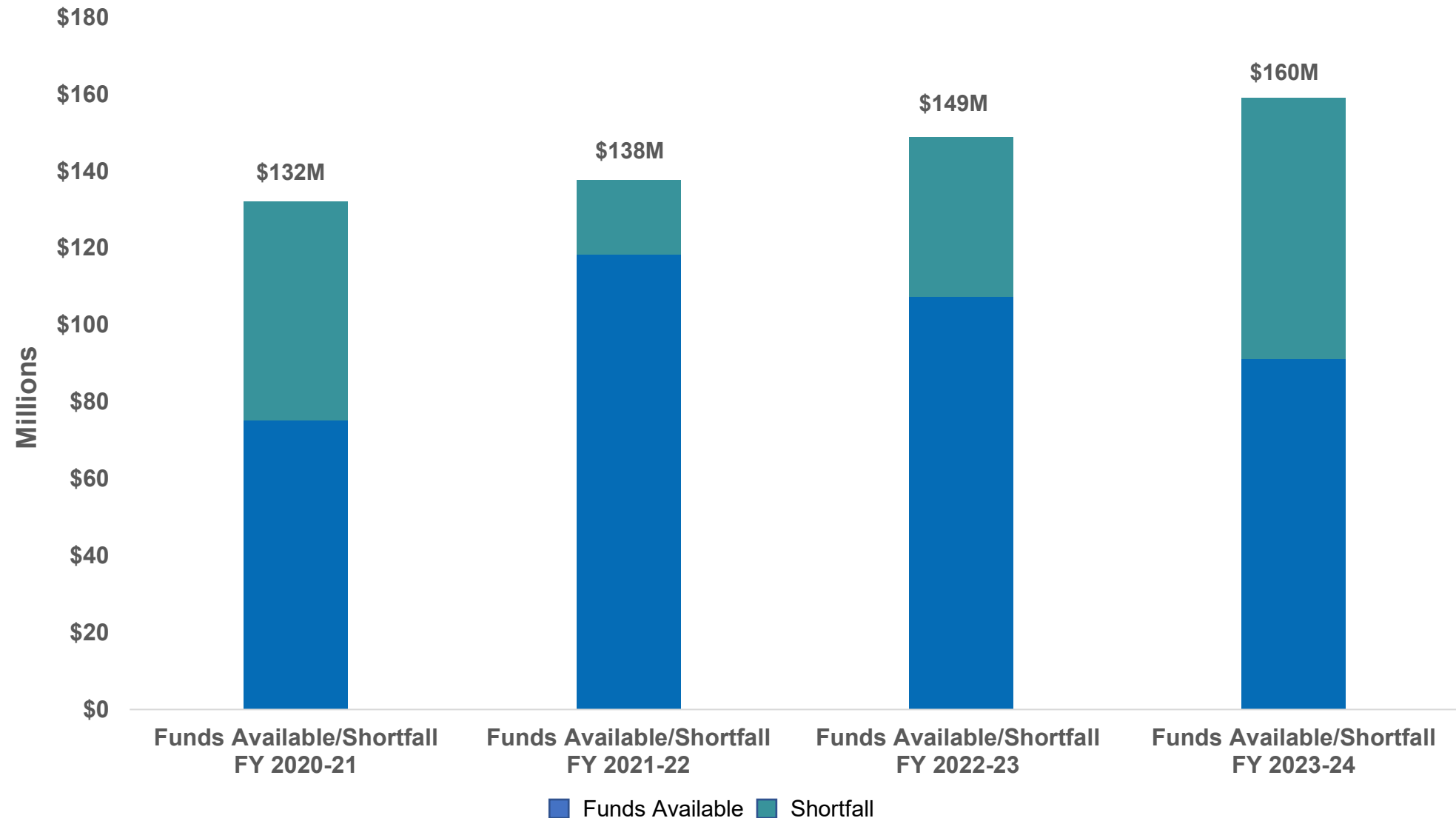

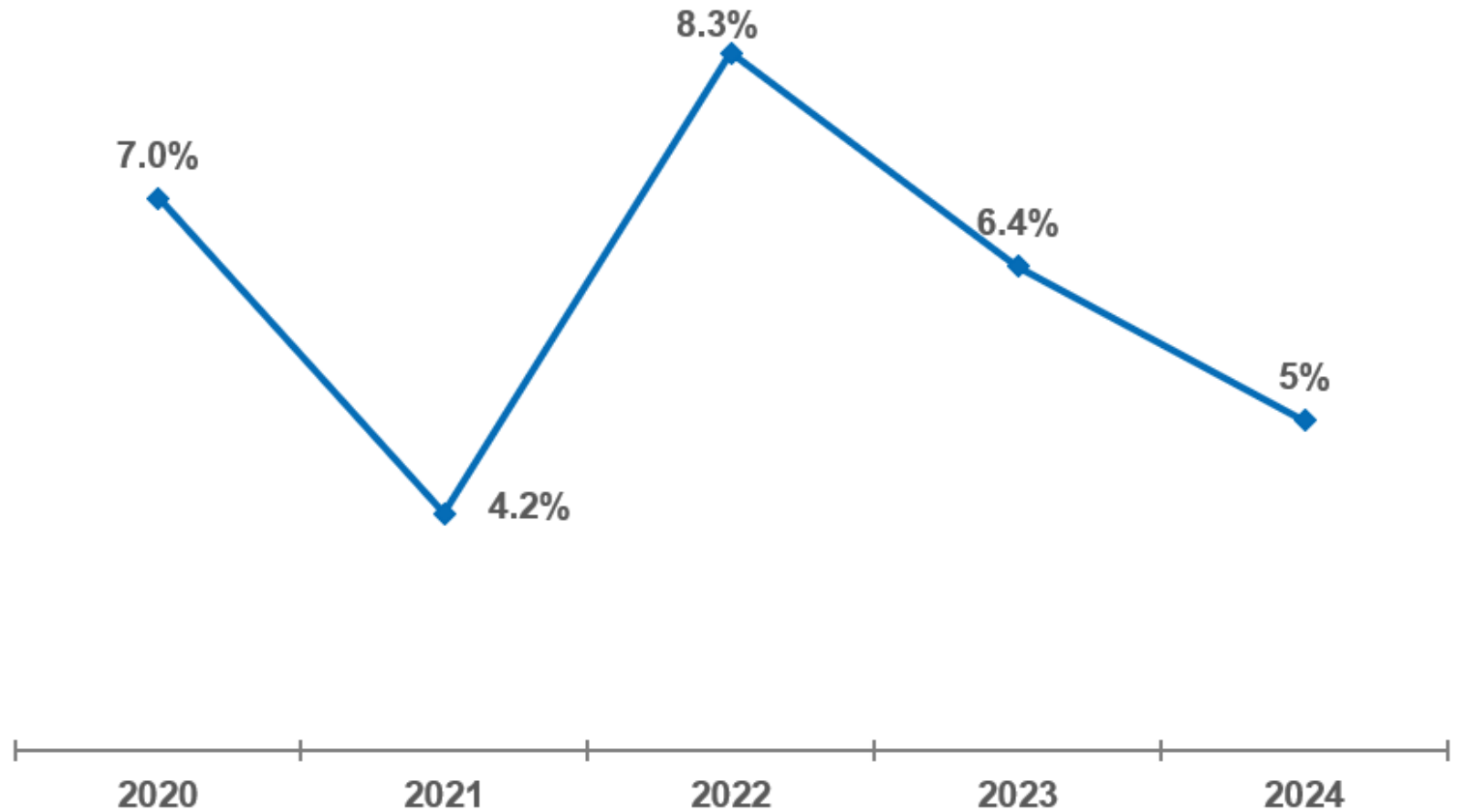

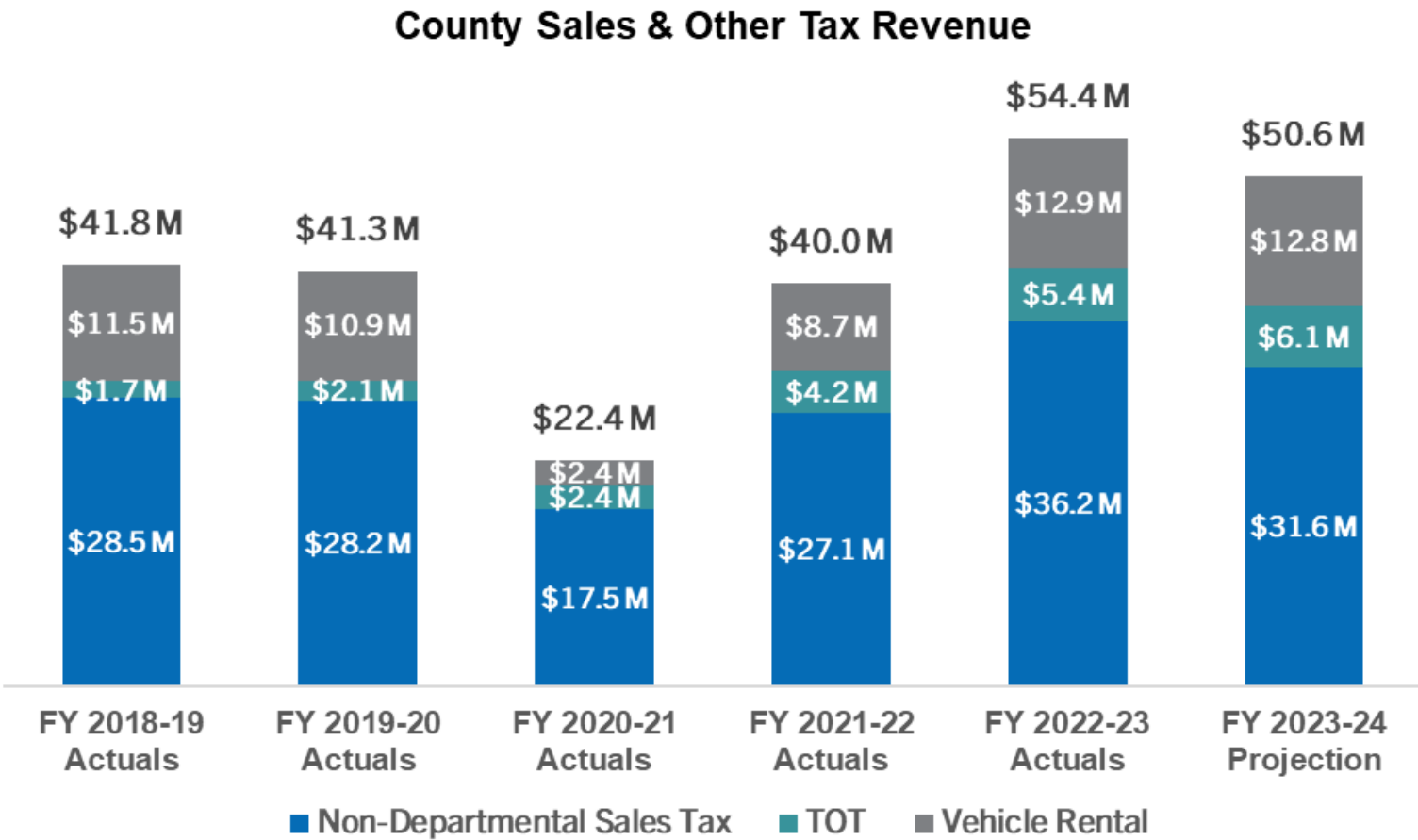


Property Tax (Roll Value)

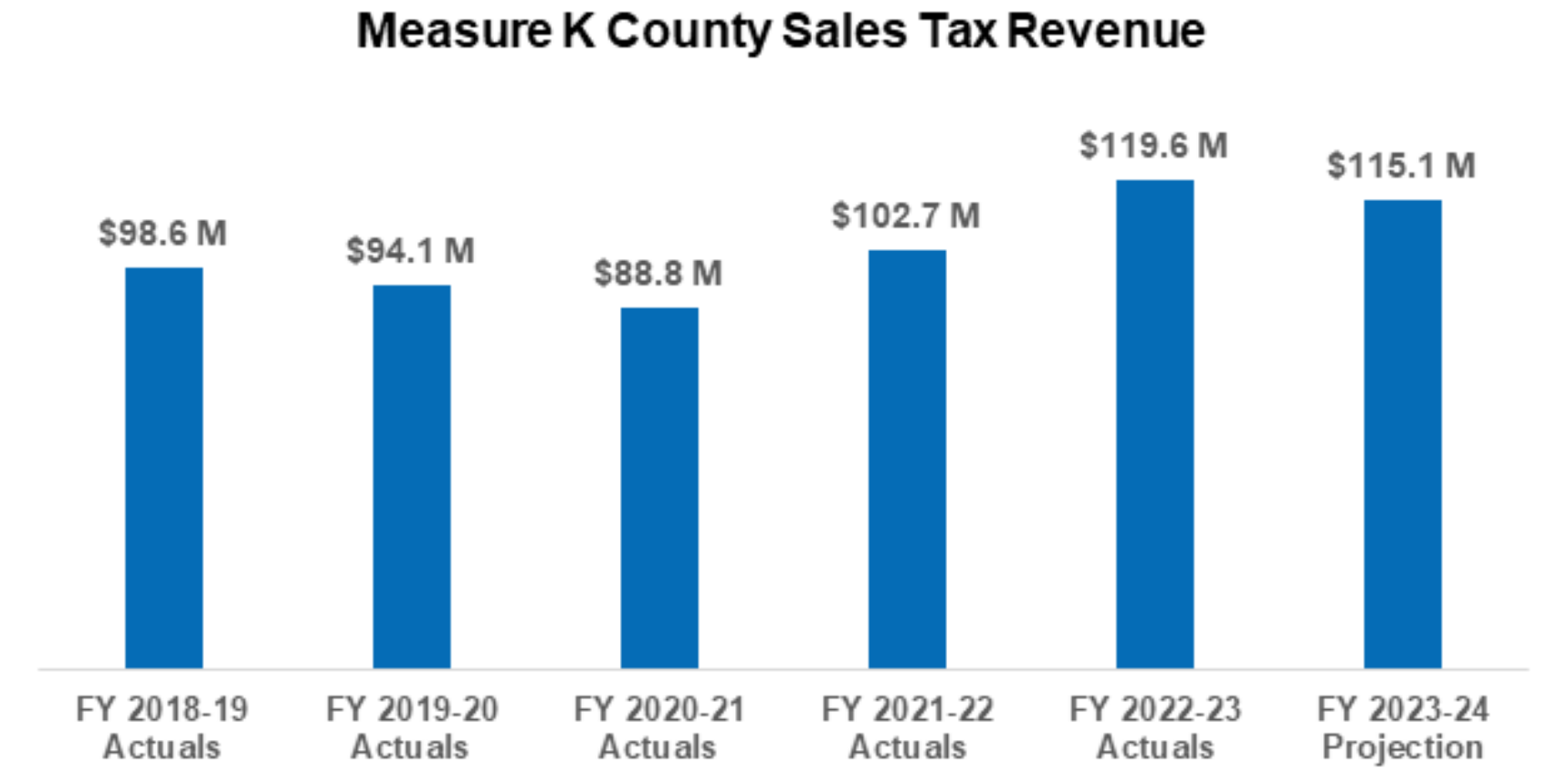
**Rate of Change in Net Combined Roll Value
(Secured & Unsecured)**

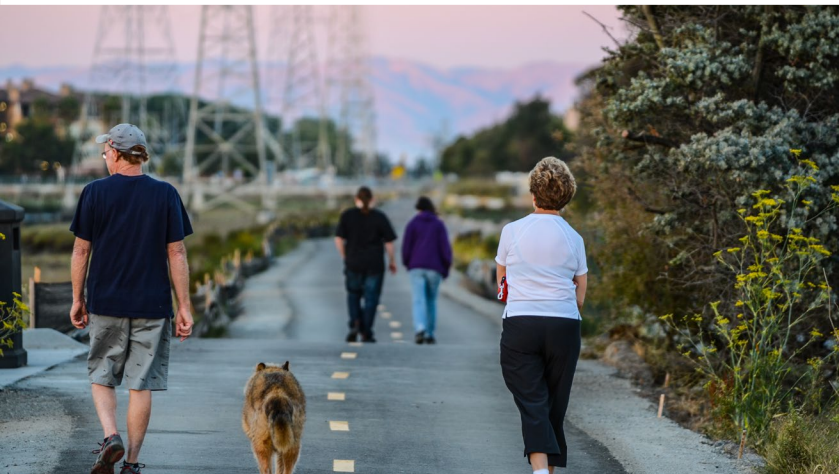
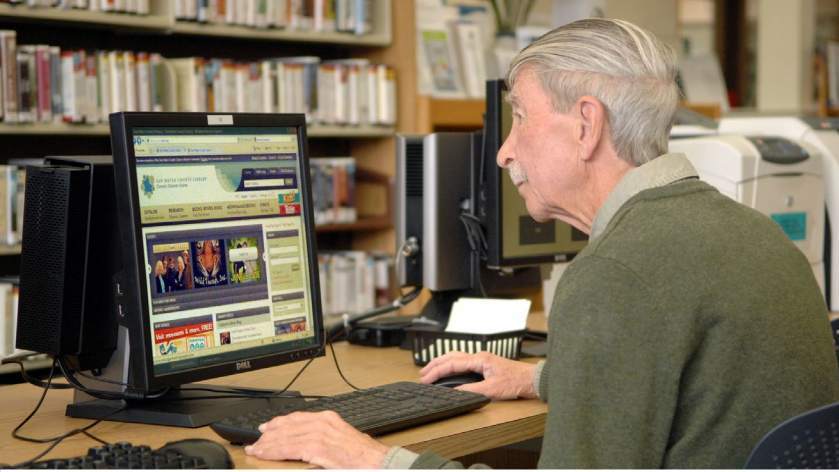


County Sales & Other Tax Revenue



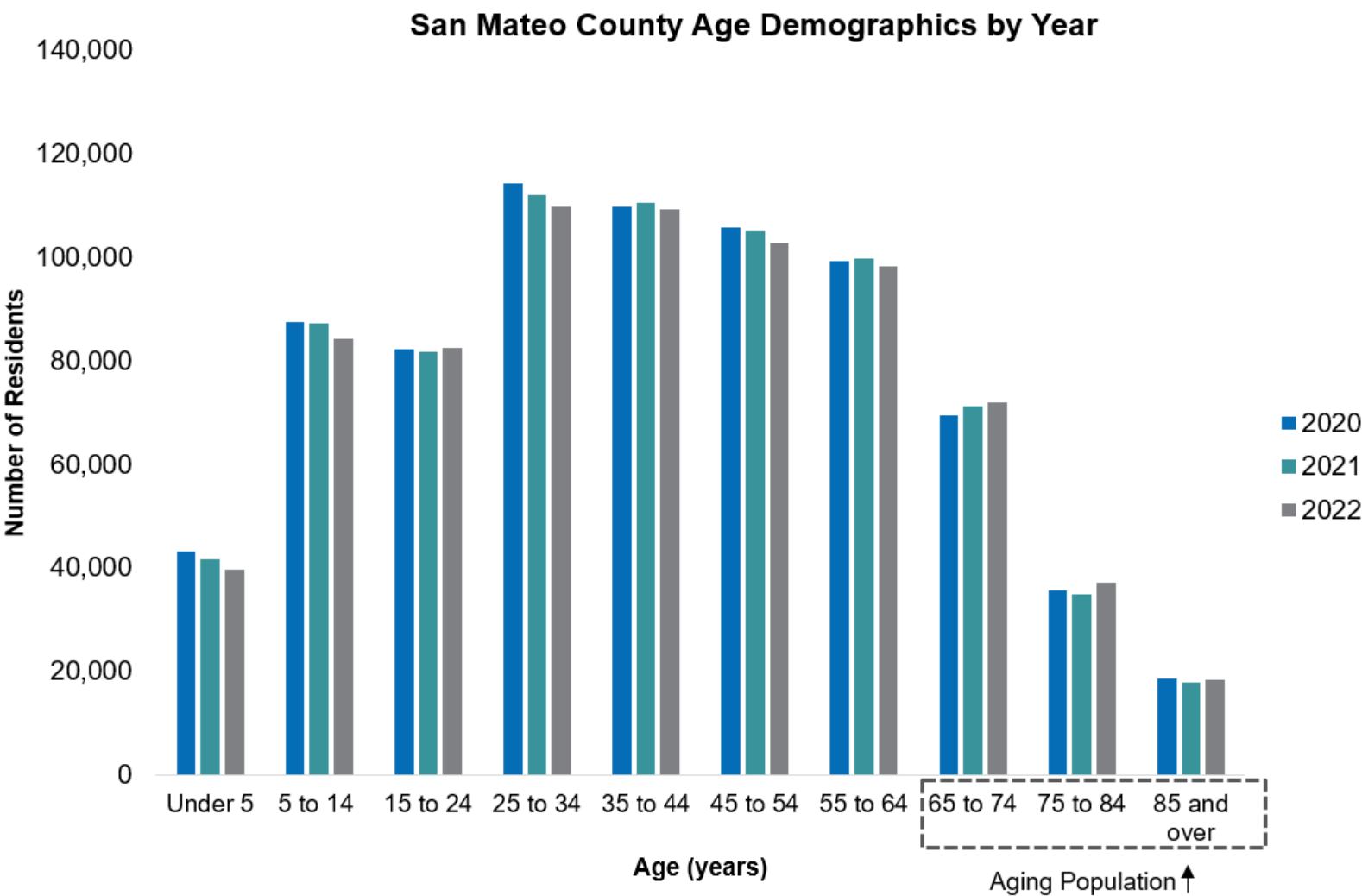
Measure K County Sales Tax Revenue



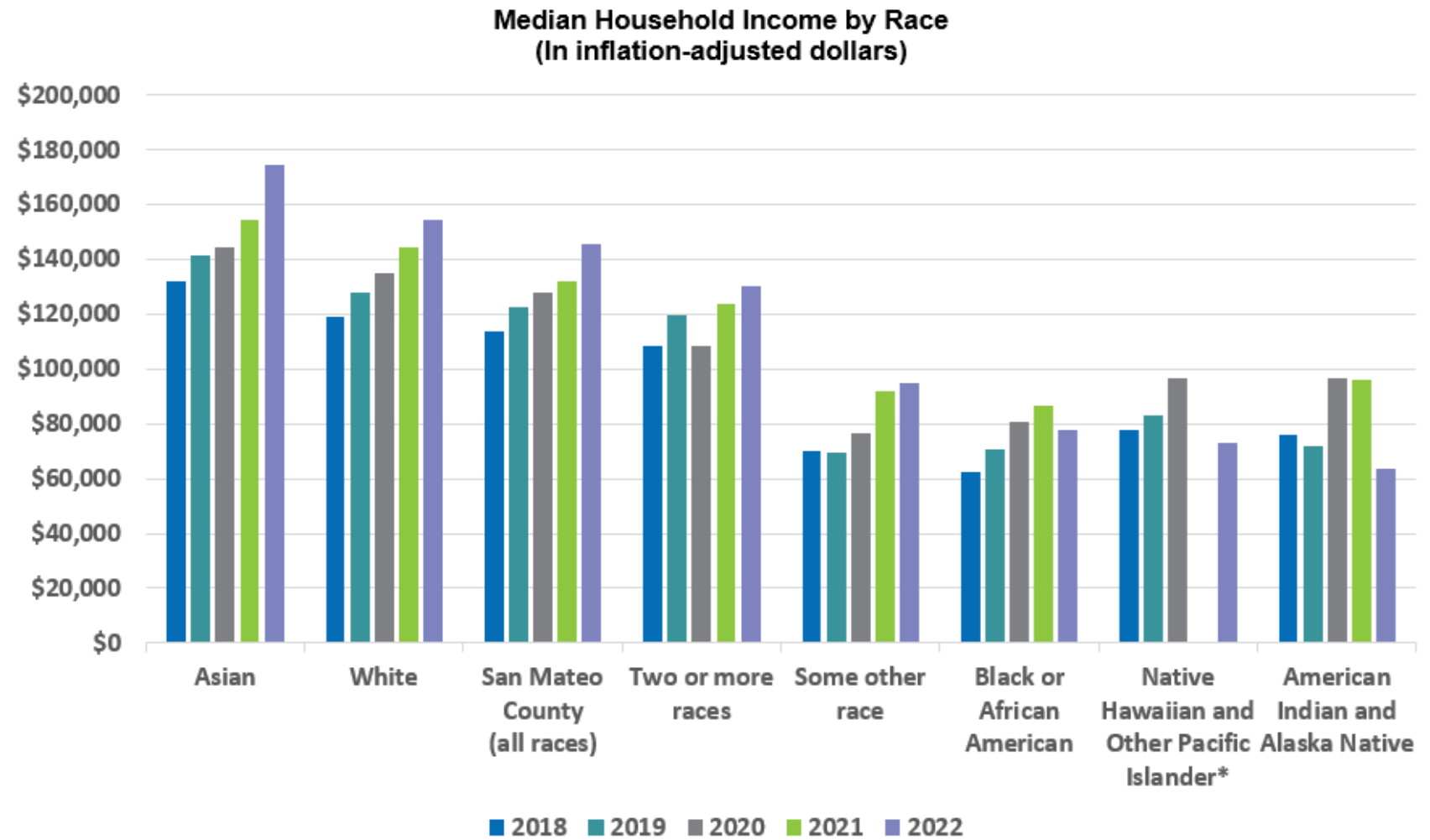

County Demographics by Age

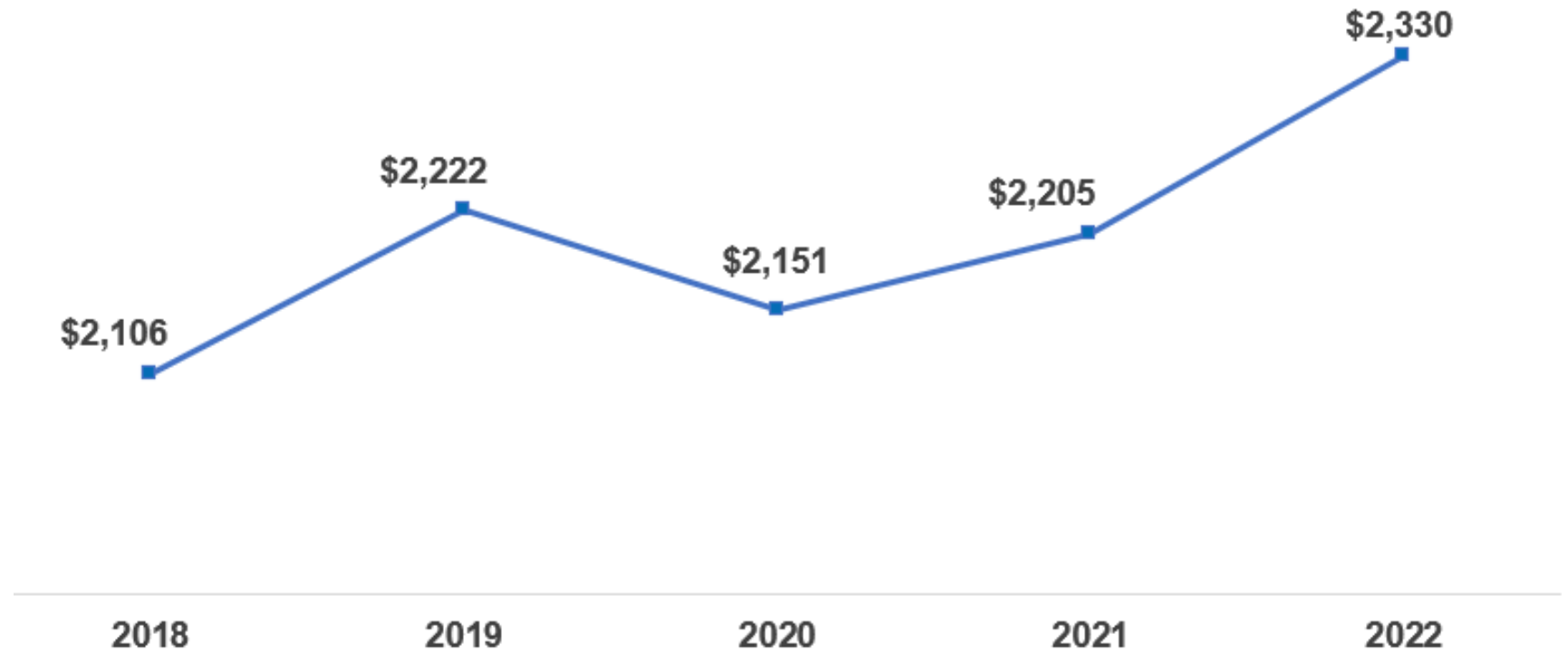


Median Household Income
