BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, COUNTY OF SAN MATEO, STATE OF CALIFORNIA

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RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY, OR DESIGNEE, TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH THE NORTHERN CALIFORNIA REGIONAL INTELLIGENCE CENTER TO SUPPORT THE HUMAN TRAFFICKING UNIT WITH THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY’S OFFICE, FOR THE TERM OF MAY 21, 2026 TO MAY 21, 2027, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$250,000

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the Human Trafficking (HT) unit is a unit, within the San Mateo County District Attorney’s Office, led by the District Chief Inspector or Senior Inspector (“DA Inspector”); and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the HT is to provide labor and sex trafficking investigations and initiatives in San Mateo County; and

WHEREAS, the County has partnered with the Northern California Regional Intelligence Center (NCRIC) to provide one NCRIC Intelligence Analyst to support the District Attorney’s Human Trafficking unit by reviewing local, state and federal law enforcement systems and public databases for indication of human trafficking in San Mateo county, generate monthly and quarterly intelligence reports, provide case support and human trafficking field operations support to San Mateo county law enforcement

partners, and distribute information and intelligence from findings, assessments, and investigations; and

WHEREAS, this Board has been presented with an agreement with the NCRIC as described in the board memorandum accompanying this resolution, in an amount not to exceed \$250,000 for a term of May 21, 2026 to May 21, 2027; and

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the President of the Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorizes and directed to execute said agreement with the Northern California Regional Intelligence Center and the Clerk of the Board shall attest to the President's signature thereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Executive or designee is authorized to exercise the contractual options set forth in the agreements at their sole discretion and is further authorized to execute amendments to the agreements which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in aggregate per agreement), and/or modify the contract term and/or services, so long as the modified contract term or services is/are within the current revised fiscal provisions.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the District Attorney (DA) or DA's designee is authorized to execute contract amendments which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in aggregate), and/or modify the contract term and/or services so long as the modified term of services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.

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
