RESOLUTION HONORING AND COMMENDING

North Coast County Water District
Upon Its 80 Years of Service

WHEREAS, the **NORTH COAST COUNTY WATER DISTRICT** has been a dedicated public agency, providing safe, high-quality water to the residents of the City of Pacifica since its establishment in 1944, and is committed to its mission of delivering a sufficient quantity of high-quality water in the most cost-effective, reliable, and environmentally sensitive manner; and

WHEREAS, the **NORTH COAST COUNTY WATER DISTRICT** has shown a long-standing commitment to the broader community by leasing over 500 acres of land to the County of San Mateo for \$1 for 99 years in the 1960s, thereby helping to create San Pedro Valley Park; and

WHEREAS, the **NORTH COAST COUNTY WATER DISTRICT**, since its inception via a community election in 1944, has continuously ensured that 100% of its potable water supply comes from the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission (SFPUC) Regional Water System, sourced from isolated watersheds in Yosemite National Park and protected local watersheds, and the District regularly monitors the water supply to maintain quality that meets all standards set by the California Department of Public Health and the United States Environmental Protection Agency; and

WHEREAS, the **NORTH COAST COUNTY WATER DISTRICT** is a leader in water resource management and conservation, actively promoting water-wise practices through various programs such as the provision of free conservation tools, a Waterwise Garden Contest, rebates, and the operation of a Residential Recycled Water Fill Station for non-potable irrigation use; and

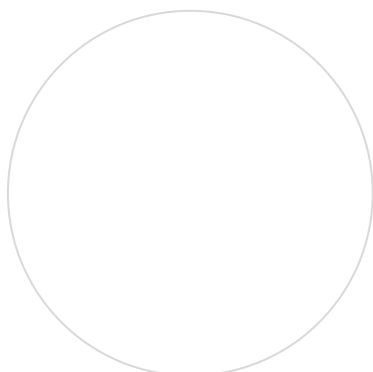
WHEREAS, the **NORTH COAST COUNTY WATER DISTRICT** is proactively investing in the reliability and future of its water supply through major projects, including the construction of a new 600,000-gallon Sheila water storage tank to replace an undersized 1955 tank, and has been awarded a \$6.6 million state grant for a Potable Groundwater Supply Well Project to develop new local water sources and reduce reliance on the SFPUC Regional Water System; and

WHEREAS, the **NORTH COAST COUNTY WATER DISTRICT** is committed to customer service and operational efficiency, working to implement Advanced Metering Infrastructure (AMI) technology by Spring 2026 to allow for remote meter reading, real-time water usage data for customers, and swift leak detection to improve water conservation; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo wishes to recognize and commend the dedication of the **North Coast County Water District's** Board, staff, and employees for their persistent commitment to public health, safety, environmental stewardship, and the provision of essential services to the residents of Pacifica.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, hereby honors and commends the **North Coast County Water District** for its enduring commitment to delivering high-quality water and for its innovative leadership in water management, conservation, and community well-being.
