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**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH
STARVISTA TO PROVIDE DIFFERENTIAL RESPONSE SERVICES,
EXTENDING THE TERM OF THE AGREEMENT BY ONE YEAR THROUGH
DECEMBER 5, 2019 AND INCREASING THE AMOUNT BY \$1,153,407 TO AN
AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$2,000,314**

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, Differential Response (DR) is an evidence-based prevention and early-intervention strategy provided to family units to reduce child abuse and neglect and provide for a holistic, flexible, and customized approach to reports of child abuse and neglect; and

WHEREAS, in April 2017, the Human Services Agency issued a Request for Proposals seeking early intervention services through a DR model and aftercare services for reunified families, and StarVista was selected; and

WHEREAS, on December 5, 2017 the County authorized an agreement with StarVista, by resolution number 075605, to provide DR services to the northern, central, and coastal regions of San Mateo County in the amount of \$846,907 and the term of December 6, 2017 through December 5, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the parties wish to amend the agreement increasing the funding by \$1,153,407 for a new total obligation amount not to exceed \$2,000,314 and extending the term by one year through December 5, 2019 to allow StarVista to continue providing

DR services in the northern, central and coastal regions of San Mateo and to expand DR services to include the southern region; and

WHEREAS, this Board has been presented with a form of said amendment, has examined and approved it as to form and content, and desires to enter into it.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the President of this Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized and directed to execute said amendment for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, and the Clerk of this Board shall attest the President's signature thereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of the Human Services Agency or the Director's designee is hereby authorized to execute contract amendments which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in aggregate), and/or modify the contract term and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.

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
