Update, Goal, Objectives

Update

 Through the cooperation of County Departments, such as Parks, Elections, DPW, PDU, Health, the committee has kept current with ongoing projects.

Hate Crimes & Abuse Against People with Disabilities

2022-2023 Updates:

- The Abuse Roundtable Group, created in 2019 by a CoD Commissioner and the DA's Office to address abuse against individuals with disabilities, established a workgroup to explore creating a statewide Abusive Caregiver Registry.
- The Legislation Advocacy and Outreach Committee supports and organizes the registry workgroup with the ultimate goal of having Disability Rights California (DRC) and other advocates for the disabled community propose its establishment to the state legislature.
