### RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A “NO PARKING” ZONE ON SPRING STREET IN UNINCORPORATED REDWOOD CITY

**RESOLVED**, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

**WHEREAS**, California Vehicle Code Section 22507 et al. and section 7.30.010 of the County of San Mateo Ordinance Code allow the Board of Supervisors to establish parking zones that prohibit or restrict the stopping, parking, or standing of vehicles; and

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Public Works (Department) received a request to restrict parking at 2581 Spring Street in the unincorporated area of Redwood City to prevent vehicles from parking in a small parking space between a curb return and the business’s driveway access approach; and

**WHEREAS**, the Director of Public Works recommends establishing a “No Parking” zone on Spring Street; and

**WHEREAS**, this Board has reviewed and concurs with the recommendation of the Director of Public Works

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS FURTHER DETERMINED AND ORDERED** that:

A “No Parking” zone be established at the following location:

1. 2581 Spring Street (Road #660B), unincorporated Redwood City, 25 feet west of the centerline of Douglas Avenue, and continuing on the northern side of Spring Street for 20 feet, more, or less.

2. The Department of Public Works is authorized and directed to post any necessary signs and pavement markings.
