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RESOLUTION:

A) ADOPTING THE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, INCLUDING CONFORMANCE WITH PREVAILING WAGE SCALE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE 795 SKYWAY ROAD BUILDING REPLACEMENT PROJECT AT THE SAN CARLOS AIRPORT; AND
B) AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS TO CALL FOR SEALED BIDS TO BE RECEIVED BY THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 19, 2026 AT 2:00 P.M. IN THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE OFFICE/CLERK OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS; AND
C) AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS TO EXTEND THE CALL FOR BIDS AND BID OPENING UP TO SIXTY (60) CALENDAR DAYS BEYOND THE TIME AND DATE ORIGINALLY SET FORTH BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the 795 Skyway Road Building Replacement Project (Project) is located at the San Carlos Airport, in San Mateo County; and

WHEREAS, the Project was originally designed in 2019 and was delayed due to the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, the Project will demolish and replace the existing structure which has far exceeded its useful life and presents ongoing safety and code compliance issues; and

WHEREAS, plans and specifications dated January 23, 2026 have been prepared and approved by the Director of Public Works for the Project, and said plans and specifications have been filed in the office of the Director of Public Works (the “plans and specifications”); and

WHEREAS, the plans and specifications require that the contractors performing the work pay not less than the general prevailing wages, as established by the Department of Industrial Relations, in the locality in which said work is to be performed for each type of worker needed to execute the contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED as follows:

1. The plans and specifications dated January 23, 2026 for the aforesaid Project, which are on file in the office of the Director of Public Works, and to which reference is hereby made for further particulars, are hereby approved and adopted as the plans and specifications to be adhered to in letting and performing the work under a contract for the improvements described therein.
2. Said specifications require that the contractors performing the work pay not less than the general prevailing wages, as established by the Department of Industrial Relations, in the locality in which said work is to be performed for each type of worker needed to execute the contract.
3. The Department of Public Works is authorized and directed to issue a call for sealed bids and to set the bid opening date and time on Thursday, February 19, 2026 at 2:00 p.m. Said bids will be received in the office of the County Executive Officer/Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in 500 County Center, Redwood City, California. Said bids will be received by the Clerk of

the Board of Supervisors and then transmitted to the County Executive's Office in 500 County Center and be publicly opened and declared.

4. The Director of Public Works is authorized to extend the call for bids and bid opening up to sixty (60) calendar days beyond the time and date originally set forth by the Board of Supervisors.

5. The Department of Public Works is further directed to cause the Notice inviting sealed bids to be published for two (2) times in a weekly local newspaper of general circulation, published in the County, and obtain an affidavit of said publication, a copy of which shall be placed on file with the Department of Public Works.

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
