WHEREAS, The Peninsula Bay Chapter of The Links, Incorporated was chartered on November 5, 1960, in Palo Alto, California, by fifteen civic-minded women who united in their commitment to serve the communities of San Mateo and Santa Clara counties; and

WHEREAS, these visionary women, with sponsorship from the San Francisco Chapter, became the sixth chapter established in California, and only six years later, in 1966, proudly hosted the Western Area Conference; and

WHEREAS, for sixty-five years, **the Peninsula Bay Chapter of The Links, Incorporated** has upheld a long-standing tradition of awarding scholarships to deserving high school seniors, funding these opportunities through creative and impactful events; and

WHEREAS, the Peninsula Bay Chapter of The Links, Incorporated has partnered with a wide range of community organizations to advance equity, education, and well-being, including the YMCA and Senior Center in East Palo Alto, the Girls’ Club, Volunteers of America, Domini Hoskins Black History Museum and Learning Center, Malaika House, and the Ecumenical Hunger Program, among others; and

WHEREAS, the Peninsula Bay Chapter of The Links, Incorporated has also initiated innovative projects such as a grant-funded gardening program with Girls to Women in East Palo Alto, and its members have volunteered annually in the Soul Stroll as part of the African-American Health Initiative; and

WHEREAS, on Saturday, November 8, 2025, **the Peninsula Bay Chapter of The Links, Incorporated** will celebrate its 65th Anniversary at a special luncheon at the Saratoga Country Club, marking more than six decades of extraordinary service and sisterhood;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, hereby recognizes and commends **the Peninsula Bay Chapter of The Links, Incorporated** for sixty-five years of outstanding leadership, service, and community partnership, and extends its deepest gratitude and congratulations on this milestone anniversary.
