BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, COUNTY OF SAN MATEO, STATE OF CALIFORNIA

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ADOPT A RESOLUTION WAIVING THE REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS PROCESS AND AUTHORIZING THE HUMAN SERVICES AGENCY AND SAN MATEO COUNTY HEALTH TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE GEORGIA STATE UNIVERSITY RESEARCH FOUNDATION TO PROVIDE SAFECARE® CERTIFICATION TRAINING IN THE AMOUNT OF \$122,256 FOR THE TERM OF March 26, 2019 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2020

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the National SafeCare® and Research Center (NSTRC), founded in 2007 by the Georgia State University Research Foundation (GSURF), is a research and evidenced-based parenting education program for families with children ages zero to five that addresses risk factors for child abuse and neglect through three modules: parent-child relationship, home safety, and child health; and

WHEREAS, under the SafeCare® model, certified providers work with parents or caregivers of children who are at-risk of or reported for child maltreatment and are taught how to interact in a positive manner with their children, recognize hazards in the home, and recognize and respond to symptoms of illness and injury; and

WHEREAS, the Human Services Agency's (HSA) Children and Family Services branch (CFS) and San Mateo County Health's Family Health Services (FHS) division would like to collaboratively enter into an Agreement with the GSURF to provide SafeCare® training and implement the SafeCare® model in San Mateo County; and

WHEREAS, GSURF will provide SafeCare® certification training to CFS and FHS staff that specifically serve child welfare clients to prepare staff for providing in-home services using the SafeCare® model, and onsite coaching for providers for the term of March 26, 2019 through June 30, 2020 for the total obligation of \$122,256; and

WHEREAS, this Board has approved this Agreement as to form and content and desires to enter into the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, GSURF is the only provider that offers evidenced-based curriculum targeted to parents with children ages zero (0) to five (5) through in-home modules focused on safety, well-being, and parent education; and

WHEREAS, this Board has determined that the best interest of the County will be served by waiving the Request for Proposals process; and

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the Request for Proposals process be waived and the President of this Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized and directed to execute said Agreement on behalf of the County of San Mateo, and the Clerk of this Board shall attest the President's signature thereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of the Human Services Agency (HSA) or the Director's designee is hereby authorized to execute contract amendments which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in aggregate), and/or modify the contract term and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.

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
