DREAMers' Roadmap
On Its 10th Anniversary

WHEREAS, DREAMer's Roadmap was founded in 2015 by Sarahi Espinoza Salamanca, a nationally recognized Latina social entrepreneur and Forbes 30 Under 30 honoree, Stanford Knight Hennessy Scholar and White House Champion of Change; who turned her own experiences as an undocumented student into a mission-driven effort to ensure others have access to higher education; and

WHEREAS, DREAMer's Roadmap developed the first free national mobile app of its kind, helping undocumented youth identify and apply for scholarships and financial opportunities to make college a reality; and

WHEREAS, over the last decade, DREAMer's Roadmap has supported more than 34,000 students across the country, providing hope and opportunity to young people who too often believe that higher education is out of reach; and

WHEREAS, DREAMer's Roadmap has also responded to broader community needs, including leading emergency relief efforts, distributing essential supplies to farmworker families, and hosting innovative events such as the Dreamer Hackathon, all while growing a volunteer-powered team committed to equity and access; and

WHEREAS, DREAMer's Roadmap continues its work today by connecting undocumented youth with critical scholarship resources, expanding partnerships, and advocating for the educational dreams of the next generation of immigrant students; and

WHEREAS, DREAMer's Roadmap's mission and impact are especially resonant during Hispanic Heritage Month, a time to celebrate the rich contributions of Latino leaders and community organizations that empower and uplift our communities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, hereby honors and congratulates **DREAMer's Roadmap** on its 10th Anniversary and extends sincere appreciation for its decades of continued commitment to undocumented youth, equity in education, and the broader immigrant community.
