#### **RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO MASTER SALARY RESOLUTION 081316 TO DELETE FOUR POSITIONS AND ADD FIVE POSITIONS**

**RESOLVED**, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

**WHEREAS**, section 206a(4) of the San Mateo County Charter authorizes the Board of Supervisors to establish the number of all appointed officers and employees; and

**WHEREAS**, sections 206a(5) and 508 of the San Mateo County Charter authorize the Board of Supervisors to establish by ordinance or resolution the compensation and benefits of County officers and employees; and

**WHEREAS**, San Mateo County Ordinance No. 073703 ordered that henceforth the number of County appointed officers and employees and their compensation and benefits shall be established by resolution of the Board of Supervisors; and

**NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the Board of Supervisors authorizes an amendment to Master Salary Resolution 081316 as follows:

**SECTION 1:** Section 14 of the Resolution is amended as indicated:

#### 12000 COUNTY EXECUTIVE/CLERK OF THE BOARD

1. Item D218, Project Development Director is decreased by 1 for a new total of 0 positions.

2. Item N108, Capital Projects Manager II is decreased by 2 for a new total of 0 positions.
3. Item D182S, Management Analyst Series is decreased by 1 for a new total of 15 positions.

#### 47300 DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS-FACILITIES SERVICES

1. Item D229, Capital Programs Manager is increased by 1 for a new total of 2 positions.
2. Item D170, Senior Capital Projects Manager is increased by 1 for a new total of 2 positions.
3. Item N108, Capital Projects Manager II is increased by 1 for a new total of 7 positions.
4. Item D182S, Management Analyst Series is increased by 1 for a new total of 2 positions.
5. Item E007, Senior Accountant is increased by 1 for a new total of 1 position.
