**BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, COUNTY OF SAN MATEO, STATE OF CALIFORNIA**

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**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE TO EXECUTE A THIRD  
AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH CARPI AND CLAY, LLC FOR FEDERAL  
ADVOCACY SERVICES EXTENDING THE TERM THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2025  
AND INCREASING THE AMOUNT BY \$96,000 FOR A NEW NOT TO EXCEED  
AMOUNT OF \$384,000**

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**RESOLVED**, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

**WHEREAS**, an estimated 80 percent of the County's budget is dependent on funds provided in support of both state and federally mandated partnership programs and services. It is therefore imperative that the County be actively involved and well represented in the development of both state and federal policy, programs, and funding priorities; and

**WHEREAS**, effective legislative participation and advocacy are critical to county government and many local programs; and

**WHEREAS**, a competitive Request for Proposals process was conducted in the fall of 2021 and resulted in the recommendation that the County contract with Carpi & Clay, Inc. to perform the County's federal advocacy activities; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board has been presented for its consideration and acceptance an agreement, reference to which is hereby made for further particulars, whereby Carpi & Clay, Inc. shall continue to provide federal legislative advocacy services for the term of January 1, 2024 through December 31, 2025; and

**WHEREAS**, the parties wish to increase the not to exceed amount by \$96,000 for a new not to exceed amount of \$384,000.

**WHEREAS**, this Board of Supervisors has approved the agreement as to both form and content and desires to enter into the agreement.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED** that the President of this Board of Supervisors authorizes and directs the County Executive to execute said amendment to the agreement for federal legislative advocacy services with Carpi & Clay, Inc. for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo and the Clerk of this Board shall attest the President's signature thereto.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Board of Supervisors authorizes the County Executive or the County Executive's designee to execute amendments which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in aggregate), and/or modify the contract term and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.

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
