




#### **MONTHLY RAINFALL**




#### YEARLY RAINFALL

## Sustainable Agriculture Report








- Pest Exclusion Inspect imported shipments of agricultural products
- Pest Detection Deploy and service traps to detect and stop spread of harmful pests
  - In 2024, deployed 4,793 traps and serviced 51,668 times.
- Pest Eradication/Management
  - Lead San Mateo County Weed Management Area (WMA)
  - Active Projects for pokeweed, fertile capeweed, skeletonweed, jubata grass, and purple loosestrife

- Estimated gross production valued at \$13,755,000 across 451 acres.
