## Assemblymember Diane Papan

## as representative of California's 21st Assembly District

WHEREAS, as a former attorney and Executive Director of the nonprofit John's Closet in Daly City, providing new clothing to children in need, **Assemblymember Diane Papan**, began her public service as a councilmember on the City of San Mateo in 2015, where she served until 2022; and

WHEREAS, Assemblymember Diane Papan was elected to California's 21st Assembly District in 2022, which includes the entire Bayside of San Mateo County Brisbane to East Palo Alto; and

WHEREAS, Assemblymember Diane Papan serves as Chair of the Assembly Committee on Water, Parks and Wildlife, as well as the committees on Transportation, Judiciary, Utilities and Energy, and Environmental Safety and Toxic Materials; and

WHEREAS, for over three years, Assemblymember Diane Papan has vigorously represented the residents of the County of San Mateo, and has been a leading voice on strategies to address climate change such as flooding, drought and wildfires, as well as water quality, women's health, accessible and quality healthcare services, gun safety, affordable housing, and access to quality public education; and

WHEREAS, Assemblymember Diane Papan has been the Assembly champion spearheading advocacy efforts to secure \$109,012,253 million in in-lieu Vehicle Licensing Fee shortfall funding for the 20 municipalities of San Mateo County and the County of San Mateo, which has helped maintain essential county services, including homeless shelter operations, housing subsidies, farmworker housing, climate change and sea level rise initiatives, and wildfire prevention efforts.
