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RESOLUTION RENEWING THE DELEGATION OF INVESTMENT AUTHORITY TO THE TREASURER FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR 2026 PURSUANT TO SECTION 2.91.040 TO TITLE 2, ARTICLE 2.9 CHAPTER 2.91 OF THE SAN MATEO COUNTY ORDINANCE CODE

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, state law allows this Board of Supervisors to delegate to the County Treasurer investment authority to invest and reinvest County funds and the funds of other depositors in the County Treasury, and provides that this delegation be carried out by ordinance and subject to annual renewal by this Board; and

WHEREAS, on June 7, 2011, this Board adopted Section 2.91.040 to Title 2, Article 2.9 Chapter 2.91 of the San Mateo County Ordinance Code which delegated investment authority to the Treasurer for the 2011 calendar year and provided for the annual renewal of such delegation in subsequent years by resolution; and

WHEREAS, this Board now desires to renew its delegation of investment authority to the Treasurer for the entirety of 2026.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that this Board of Supervisors hereby delegates to the County Treasurer (Treasurer-Tax Collector) the authority to invest or reinvest the funds of the County and the funds of other depositors in the County Treasury for the entirety of calendar year 2026 pursuant to Chapter 4 (commencing with Section 53600) of Part 1 of Division 2 of Title 5 of the California Government Code.

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
