ORDINANCE ADDING SECTION 7.04.015 (SPEED LIMIT FIFTEEN MILES PER HOUR) TO CHAPTER 7.04 OF TITLE 7 OF THE SAN MATEO COUNTY ORDINANCE CODE FOR PRIMA FACIE SPEED LIMITS TO ESTABLISH A SPEED LIMIT OF 15 MILES PER HOUR ON SECTIONS OF SPRING STREET AND CAMINO AL LAGO

The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California,

ORDAINS as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 7.04.015 of Chapter 7.04 of Title 7, Vehicles and Traffic, of the San Mateo County Ordinance Code is hereby added to read as follows:

Section 7.04.015. – Speed limit fifteen miles per hour.

Prima facie speed limits of 15 miles per hour are declared to exist at the following locations while children are going to or leaving the school, either during school hours or during the noon recess period, and when approaching school grounds that are not separated from the highway by a fence, gate, or other physical barrier while the grounds are in use by children:

- Along the westbound direction of SPRING STREET between WILLOW
 STREET and a point approximately 140 feet easterly of KAYNYNE STREET.
- Along the northbound direction of CAMINO AL LAGO between BARNEY
 AVENUE and ALAMEDA DE LAS PULGAS.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall be effective thirty (30) days from the passage date thereof.
