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RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF THE FY 2023-25 CANNABIS TAX FUND GRANT PROGRAM (CTFGP) AWARDED BY THE CALIFORNIA HIGHWAY PATROL FOR DISTRIBUTION TO THE COUNTY OF SAN MATEO FOR THE TERM OF JULY 1, 2023 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2025, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$327,190.77

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the FY 2023-25 Cannabis Tax Fund Grant Program, awarded through the California Highway patrol, offers an opportunity for a California county and/or city crime laboratory that services local governments to obtain funding to improve and advance the standardization of practices in toxicology laboratories supporting and aiding in the enforcement of Driving Under the Influence (DUI) / Driving Under the Influence of Drugs (DUID) traffic laws related to alcohol and other drugs, including cannabis and cannabis products; and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Office applied for and has been awarded the FY 2023-25 Cannabis Tax Fund Grant Program in the amount of \$327,190.77, for a period commencing July 1, 2023 to June 30, 2025; and

WHEREAS, funding will assist with the purchase of additional evidential breath alcohol testing devices, a new computer and software to manage the County's Breath Alcohol Program, and funding to host training classes to certify all law enforcement officers in the County as operators of the new devices; and

WHEREAS, the California Highway Patrol requires a resolution from the Board authorizing acceptance of the grant funding.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the Board of Supervisors authorizes the Sheriff to accept the FY 2023-25 Cannabis Tax Fund Grant in the amount of \$327,190.77 and execute on behalf of the County of San Mateo all necessary applications, contracts, agreements, amendments, payment requests, and grant assurances related thereto for the purposes of securing funds and implementing and carrying out the purposes specified in the grant application.

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
