**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH
PACIFICA RESOURCE CENTER TO ADD \$488,267 IN FUNDS FOR A NEW TOTAL
OBLIGATION NOT TO EXCEED \$908,267 TO PROVIDE STREET-BASED
HOMELESS OUTREACH SERVICES**

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the Human Services Agency (HSA) coordinates homeless outreach program services to engage and stabilize homeless individuals and households living unsheltered through consistent outreach to facilitate and/or deliver health and basic need services and secure permanent housing; and

WHEREAS, on September 27, 2022 by Resolution No. 079199, this Board entered into an agreement with Pacifica Resource Center to provide homeless outreach services to the Coastsides region of San Mateo County, for the term of July 1, 2022 to June 30, 2024, for a total obligation amount not to exceed \$420,000; and

WHEREAS, HSA would like to amend the agreement to increase outreach and engagement capacity to San Mateo County's Coastsides unsheltered homeless population by adding three (3) additional full-time outreach case managers to the outreach teams and increasing the maximum amount to be expended under the Agreement by \$488,267 to an amount not to exceed \$908,267.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the President of this Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized and directed to execute said amendment for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, and the Clerk of the Board shall attest the President's signature thereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of the Human Services Agency or designee is authorized to execute contract amendments which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in the aggregate), and/or modify the contract term and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.
