RESOLUTION SETTING TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 12, 2024 AT 9:00 A.M. AT THE REGULARLY SCHEDULED BOARD MEETING AS THE TIME AND PLACE FOR A HEARING ON THE PROPOSED ANNEXATION OF THE LANDS OF FLYNN FAMILY TRUST (23 DON COURT, REDWOOD CITY, APN 058-040-180) TO THE OAK KNOLL SEWER MAINTENANCE DISTRICT

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, acting as the Governing Board of the Oak Knoll Sewer Maintenance District, that:

WHEREAS, this Board has received a request to annex the property at 23 Don Court (APN 058-040-180) to the Oak Knoll Sewer Maintenance District (District), which property is described in Exhibit “A” and Exhibit “B” hereto attached and made a part hereof by reference; and

WHEREAS, a hearing to consider said annexation is required by law.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that;

1. **Tuesday, November 12, 2024 at 9:00 A.M.**, in the Chambers of the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, 500 County Center, 1st Floor, Redwood City, California, is hereby fixed as the time and place of the hearing when and where all persons having any objection to the annexation of said property to said District may be heard.

2. The Director of Public Works, pursuant to Section 4860 et seq. of the Health and Safety Code, shall cause a copy of Exhibit "C" attached to this Resolution and headed by the words "NOTICE OF HEARING", to be published once a week for two successive weeks prior to the date set for hearing in a newspaper of general circulation in the above named District, and in the territory of the property proposed to be annexed, deemed by this Board to be most likely to give notice of public hearing to all the inhabitants of each.
3. Copies of Exhibit "C" with the heading of "NOTICE OF HEARING" in letters not less than one inch in height shall also be posted in three conspicuous places within the territory proposed to be annexed and in at least three conspicuous places in the District, not less than ten days prior to the day set for the hearing.
