RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING: A) A COMMITMENT IN AN AMOUNT TO NOT EXCEED \$800,000 OF GENERAL FUNDS TO SUPPORT THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE LOS ROBLES RONALD MCNAIR SPORTS FOR ALL HUB PROJECT TO EXPAND RECREATIONAL, ATHLETIC, AND COMMUNITY RESOURCES FOR YOUTH AND FAMILIES IN DISTRICT 4 AND THROUGHOUT THE REGION; AND B) THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE, OR DESIGNEE(S), IN CONSULTATION WITH THE COUNTY ATTORNEY, TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE A GRANT AGREEMENT AND RELATED DOCUMENTS WITH THE RAVENSWOOD CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT, THE CITY OF EAST PALO ALTO, THE BAY AREA SPORTS HUB COALITION AND/OR DESIGNATED IMPLEMENTING PARTNER(S) TO SUPPORT PROJECT DEVELOPMENT, CONSTRUCTION, AND PROGRAMMING

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the County of San Mateo is committed to advancing youth development and community well-being by expanding access to quality recreational, educational, and wellness opportunities for residents across the County; and

WHEREAS, the Los Robles Ronald McNair Sports for All Hub (“Project”) represents a collaboration among the Ravenswood City School District (“RCSD”), the City of East Palo Alto, and the Bay Area Sports Hub Coalition. This a regional partnership supported by professional sports organizations, philanthropic groups, and local governments to expand equitable access to high-quality sports and wellness facilities across the Bay Area; and

WHEREAS, the Project will be located on the shared campus of Los Robles Magnet Academy and Ronald McNair Academy, serving more than 800 students and thousands of community members in East Palo Alto and surrounding neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, the Project's goal is to create a community-led and community-owned sports space that provides safe, year-round access to physical activity, leadership development, and wellness resources; and

WHEREAS, the County's investment of \$800,000 in General Funds will support project development, construction, and programming, leveraging additional public and private funding to complete Phase I construction and ensure long-term sustainability of the facility; and

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the Board of Supervisors authorizes (A) a commitment of up to \$800,000 in General Funds to support the Los Robles Ronald McNair Sports for All Hub to expand recreational, athletic, and community resources for youth and families in District 4 and throughout the region; and (B) the County Executive, or designee(s), in consultation with the County Attorney, to negotiate and execute a grant agreement and any related documents. Amendments and certificates necessary with the Ravenswood City School District, the City of East Palo Alto, the Bay Area Sports Hub Coalition and/or designated implementing partner(s) to support project development, construction, and programming.
