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RESOLUTION SETTING THE SPECIAL PARCEL TAX AT AN ANNUAL RATE OF \$65 PER PARCEL FOR FY 2025-26 TO FUND EXTENDED POLICE AND STRUCTURAL FIRE PROTECTION SERVICES IN COUNTY SERVICE AREA NO. 1

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, acting as the Governing Board of County Service Area No. 1, that:

WHEREAS, a measure to renew a special parcel tax to provide additional funding for extended police and structural fire protection services in County Service Area No. 1 for the period from FY 2024-25 through FY 2027-28 ("Measure B") was submitted to the voters of County Service Area No. 1 at the Presidential Primary Election on March 5, 2024; and

WHEREAS, as certified by the County's Elections Division on April 4, 2024, Measure B was approved by the voters of CSA-1 at the March 5, 2024, Presidential Primary Election with 1,360 (87.80%) of voters in support and 189 (12.20%) voters opposed; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors conducted a public hearing on June 10, 2025, to set the rate of the special parcel tax amount for FY 2025-26 and duly published notification of the time, date, and place of hearing once in a newspaper of general circulation in the County Service Area No. 1, pursuant to Government Code Sections 6060 and 6061; and

WHEREAS, based on the materials presented to the Board prior to and at the public hearing, the Board desires to set the rate of the special parcel tax at \$65 per parcel for FY 2025-26.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the FY 2025-26 annual rate for the special parcel tax for extended police and structural fire protection services in County Service Area No. 1 shall be \$65 per parcel.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the County Executive, or the County Executive's designee, is hereby authorized to take such further actions as are necessary to place the parcel tax on the FY 2025-26 property tax bill for properties in CSA-1.

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
