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RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH CARAHSOFT TECHNOLOGY CORPORATION TO PROVIDE LICENSES FROM SALESFORCE AND ACCOUNTING SEED FOR ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH SERVICES DIVISION OF SAN MATEO COUNTY HEALTH, FOR THE TERM OF FEBRUARY 1, 2026 THROUGH FEBRUARY 12, 2027, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$378,805.03

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, in 2023, a Salesforce Public Sector Solution with associated Salesforce and Accounting Seed licenses purchased from Carahsoft Technology Corporation, was implemented as a records management system that would support current and future needs of Environmental Health Services (EHS) and businesses in the community; and

WHEREAS, the County and Carahsoft Technology Corporation now wish to enter into an agreement regarding licenses from Salesforce and Accounting Seed for a term from February 1, 2026 through February 12, 2027, for a total obligation amount not to exceed \$378,805.03; and

WHEREAS, this Board has been presented with a form of such agreement, has examined and approved it as to both form and content, and desires to enter into the agreement; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with County procurement policy, the County did not conduct a competitive solicitation because the purchase is being made pursuant to a competitively-bid cooperative agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized and directed to execute said agreement for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, and the Clerk of the Board shall attest the President's signature thereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chief of San Mateo County Health or designee is authorized to execute contract amendments which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in aggregate) and/or modify the contract term and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the requirement to conduct a competitive solicitation is hereby waived.

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
