

**REINSTATEMENT AND AMENDMENT TO MEASURE K GRANT AGREEMENT
BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF SAN MATEO AND
BELLE HAVEN ACTION**

THIS REINSTATEMENT AND AMENDMENT TO THE GRANT AGREEMENT is entered into this _____ day of _____, 2026, by and between the COUNTY OF SAN MATEO, hereinafter called "County," and Belle Haven Action, hereinafter called "Grantee".

W I T N E S S E T H:

WHEREAS, the parties entered into a Grant Agreement for the purchase and distribution of air filters to residents in the Belle Haven neighborhood of Menlo Park on June 10, 2025 for a term that ran through October 31, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement terminated on October 31, 2025 but the Parties now wish to reinstate and amend the Agreement to change the scope of services and extend the term through January 31, 2027,

WHEREAS, the parties wish to reinstate and amend the Grant Agreement to amend the grant's scope of services to support a 3-4 month Farmer's Market Pilot Program and change the grant term period to June 1, 2026 through January 31, 2027.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY AGREED BY THE PARTIES HERETO AS FOLLOWS:

1. The first paragraph of Section 3 of the agreement, Term & Termination, is amended to read as follows:

Reinstatement of Agreement. The termination of the Agreement is hereby rescinded and, except as expressly modified herein, the Agreement shall be, and hereby is, reinstated in its entirety and shall be in full force and effect as if the Agreement had never been terminated. Subject to compliance with all terms and conditions, the term of this Agreement shall begin June 1, 2026 and continue through January 31, 2027. The Agreement will not automatically renew, nor shall it create any reliance on the possibility of future grants.

2. Section 8 of the agreement, Prevailing Wage, is deleted.
3. Section 10 of the agreement, Compliance With Laws, is amended to add a second paragraph as follows:

The Grantee certifies and warrants that Grantee has fully complied, and will remain in full

compliance, with all applicable requirements of the Levine Act in connection with this Agreement, including making any required disclosures of campaign contributions to County Officers, which includes but may not be limited to elected County Officers. Elected County Officers include members of the San Mateo County Board of Supervisors, as well as the Assessor-County Clerk-Recorder, Controller, Coroner, District Attorney, Sheriff, and Tax Collector-Treasurer. Any campaign contribution required to be disclosed under the Levine Act in connection with this Agreement shall be disclosed on the County of San Mateo Levine Act Disclosure Form, a copy of which is available from the County upon request.

- 5. Original Exhibit A is replaced with Revised Exhibit A, (rev. 4/25/2026).

- 6. The first paragraph and Performance Measure of Exhibit B are amended to read as follows:

In accordance with the terms of this Grant Agreement, Grantee will provide, or cause to be provided the services for the Project detailed in Exhibit A and will report back to the County regarding various performance measures including, but not limited to, those noted below. Such reporting data shall be delivered to the County no later than January 31, 2027. In addition, Grantee agrees to provide descriptive information about the Project funded by the Measure K grant upon reasonable request of the County, including, but not limited to, the County Executive’s Office, the County Communications Officer, or the Supervisorial District Office.

- Provide culturally relevant and accessible food options to meet community needs
- Support outreach and coordination to ensure equitable access for participating families
