As an honoree at the

Millbrae Volunteers of the Year Awards

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that WAYNE J. LEE is being honored at Millbrae's 2024 Volunteers of the Year Awards Dinner for outstanding voluntary service to the community; and

WHEREAS, WAYNE J. LEE began a lifetime of community service at the age of thirteen, having served as a youth commissioner at the Civil Air Patrol and raising money for adolescent-led programs, then joining the Auxiliary of the United States Air Force and Civil Air Patrol (CAP), a volunteer organization, during his time Wayne mentored, planned and led young people to unlock their leadership and civic potential; and

WHEREAS, WAYNE J. LEE actively supports many youth programs, volunteering to coach soccer for the American Youth Soccer Organization (AY SO) and Parent-Teacher Association (PTA), continuing to be an active supporter of the Millbrae Leos Club, the youth organization of the Millbrae Lions club, which teaches youth leadership skills and the value of community service, and reorganizing the Leos to maximize leadership opportunities, growing its membership to over eighty members; and

WHEREAS, in 2008 WAYNE J. LEE was asked to form and lead the Millbrae Education Foundation (MEF), which raises funds to supplement Millbrae school programs and directly benefits thousands of students in the Millbrae school district. Today, MEF raises \$500,000 a year for elementary schools and middle schools; and

WHEREAS, WAYNE J. LEE advocated for San Mateo County to join the HepBFree Bay campaign - in San Mateo County alone, there are 10,000 cases of hepatitis B each year, and under Wayne's guidance, we received the necessary funding to successfully inform citizens of the virus' manageability and preventability. Additionally, WAYNE J. LEE has been a community leader in his roles as a Planner Commissioner, a founder of the Peninsula Asian Voter Education Program, the San Mateo County Pacific Islanders Caucus and the Millbrae Cultural Committee, and a member and former President of the Millbrae Lions Club.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California hereby honors and commends WAYNE J. LEE as an honoree at Millbrae's 2024 Volunteers of the Year Awards for outstanding volunteer service. The Board of Supervisors extends its heartfelt appreciation and congratulations.
