RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CALIFORNIA STATEWIDE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL AND HEALTH DISASTER RESPONSE MUTUAL AID AND MUTUAL ASSISTANCE WITH COUNTIES IN CALIFORNIA OUTSIDE OF REGION II

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the State of California has established a Medical Mutual Aid system to facilitate medical and health situational awareness and resource requests in a disaster, from the event to the county/operational area, region, and state; and

WHEREAS, the County of San Mateo, a member of California Medical Mutual Aid Region II may freely provide/receive mutual medical and health disaster aid with Region II member entities; and

WHEREAS, recent disasters in California have overwhelmed local emergency medical and health response systems within specific medical and health mutual aid regions; and

WHEREAS, there is no agreement between the counties and local health jurisdictions for sharing resources and/or financial responsibility for reimbursement outside of ones assigned region; and

WHEREAS, the Board has been presented for its consideration and acceptance a statewide Memorandum of Understanding (MOU), reference to which is hereby made for further particulars, to allow impacted and unimpacted counties outside of assigned

regions to share resources and seek reimbursement during disasters, in accordance with state and federal disaster relief fund requirements; and

WHEREAS, all parties now wish to enter into an MOU; and

WHEREAS, the Board has been presented with the MOU and examined and approved it as to both form and content and desires to enter into the agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the President of this Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized and directed to execute said MOU for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, and the Clerk of this Board shall attest the President's signature thereto.
