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**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SUBMITTAL OF A GRANT APPLICATION AND  
REQUIRED SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS TO THE CALIFORNIA STATE PARKS  
DIVISION OF BOATING AND WATERWAYS FOR GRANT FUNDING FROM THEIR  
SHORELINE EROSION CONTROL PROGRAM IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,463,765  
FOR THE MIRADA ROAD PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE REPLACEMENT AND BANK  
STABILIZATION PROJECT**

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**RESOLVED**, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

**WHEREAS**, the County of San Mateo is eligible to receive federal, state or other funding for certain projects, which funds are administered by the State of California, Federal Agencies, and other organizations; and

**WHEREAS**, the California State Parks Division of Boating and Waterways has a Shoreline Erosion Control Program, which provides grant funding opportunities; and

**WHEREAS**, the Department has determined that the proposed Mirada Road Pedestrian Bridge Replacement and Bank Stabilization Project is an appropriate and eligible project for grant funding from the California State Parks Division of Boating and Waterways Shoreline Erosion Control Program and intends to apply for this funding in the amount of \$1,463,765; and

**WHEREAS**, this Board of Supervisors wishes to delegate authority to the Director of Public Works or his/her duly authorized representative to submit a grant application and required supporting documents to the California State Parks Division of Boating and Waterways for grant funding from their Shoreline Erosion Control Program

for the Mirada Road Pedestrian Bridge Replacement and Bank Stabilization Project;  
and

**WHEREAS**, a resolution authorizing submittal of an application is required as supporting documentation by the California State Parks Division of Boating and Waterways for grant applications to their agency.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED** that:

1. The Director of Public Works or his/her duly authorized representative is authorized to submit grant applications and required supporting documents to the California State Parks Division of Boating and Waterways for grant funding from their Shoreline Erosion Control Program for the Mirada Road Pedestrian Bridge Replacement and Bank Stabilization Project on the County's behalf.
2. An application by the Department be made to the California State Parks Division of Boating and Waterways to obtain a grant, in the amount of \$1,463,765 from their Shoreline Erosion Control Program, for the Mirada Road Pedestrian Bridge Replacement and Bank Stabilization Project.

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
