RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF AN AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA BOARD OF STATE AND COMMUNITY CORRECTIONS (BSCC) FOR DISTRIBUTION OF THE FY 2025 EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT (JAG) PROGRAM FUNDS TO THE COUNTY OF SAN MATEO SHERIFF'S OFFICE, FOR THE TERM OF OCTOBER 1, 2025 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2026, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$578,998

**RESOLVED,** by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the JAG Program funds will support a range of program areas including law enforcement, prosecution, courts, crime prevention and education, drug treatment and enforcement, technology improvement, and mental health programs and related law enforcement and corrections programs; and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Office applied for and has been awarded the FY 2025 Edward Byrne Memorial JAG Program grant in the amount of \$578,998, for a period commencing October 1, 2025 to September 30, 2026; and

WHEREAS, funding will enable the Sheriff's Office Forensic Laboratory to purchase a 3D imaging platform for firearms evidence, storage for crime scene investigation gear, training room furnishings and instructional equipment, analytical scales for controlled substances analysis, and a powder hood for latent print processing; and

WHEREAS, funding will also support hosting a bloodstain pattern interpretation course and sending several analysts to specialized training conferences; and

WHEREAS, the Property and Evidence Bureau will acquire two mobile personnel lifts to improve evidence access; and

**WHEREAS**, the State requires a resolution from the Board authorizing execution of the grant, including any extensions or amendments thereof, before the applicable grant performance period.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the Board of Supervisors, on behalf of the County of San Mateo, hereby authorizes execution of an agreement with the State of California Board of State and Community Corrections (BSCC) for distribution of the FY 2025 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program funds to the County of San Mateo Sheriff's Office for the term of October 1, 2025 through September 30, 2026, in an amount not to exceed \$578,988, and approves the corresponding appropriation transfer request.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Sheriff or Sheriff's designee is hereby authorized and directed to execute all necessary documents in connection with this agreement.
