Amy Wooliever

In Recognition of 33 Years of Service

WHEREAS, Amy Wooliever has devoted 33 years to the La Honda-Pescadero Unified School District, first as a teacher, then as the Principal of Pescadero Elementary and Middle School, next as Principal of Pescadero High School and, for the last 14 years, as the Superintendent of the District; and

WHEREAS, Amy Wooliever established fiscal stability of the District through rigorous budget oversight and careful planning while, at the same time, doubling the salaries for beginning teachers; and

WHEREAS, Amy Wooliever has brought millions of dollars in grant funding to the La Honda-Pescadero Unified School District, including several multi-year grants from the California Department of Education, Silicon Valley Educational Initiatives and San Mateo County Measure K, allowing this rural and underfunded District to provide its students critically important educational opportunities they would not otherwise have; and

WHEREAS, Amy Wooliever has worked tirelessly to bring attention to the La Honda-Pescadero Unified School District, the smallest school district in San Mateo County by population, but one that serves a geographic area of over 175 square miles, including the communities of Pescadero, Loma Mar, and La Honda; and by traveling and speaking at conferences and at every level of government, **Amy Wooliever** has made the District visible to the wider world; and

WHEREAS, since 2020, Amy Wooliever has served as a Board Member of the Small School District Association, a critically important forum for rural Districts such as the La Honda-Pescadero Unified School District.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, hereby congratulates **Amy Wooliever** upon the occasion of her retirement from La Honda-Pescadero Unified School District and extends its best wishes for the future!
