RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE OCTOBER 2025 STRATEGIC ENERGY MASTER PLAN UPDATE IN ALIGNMENT WITH THE COUNTY'S CLIMATE ACTION GOALS AS STATED IN THE 2020 GOVERNMENT OPERATIONS CLIMATE ACTION PLAN

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo,
State of California, that

WHEREAS, on December 11, 2012 this Board adopted Resolution No.
072278, authorizing the Director of Public Works to implement the Strategic Energy
Management Plan (SEMP) which focused on energy conservation, cost reduction,
greenhouse gas (GHG) mitigation, procurement and generation of renewably
sourced energy, and overall sustainability in County-owned facilities through 2020;
and

WHEREAS, the October 2025 Strategic Energy Master Plan Update
(SEMP Update), included as Exhibit A, builds on past County successes and
incorporates the 2020 Government Operations Climate Action Plan (GOCAP),
which was adopted by this Board in 2021 and includes the goal for carbon neutrality
by 2035; and

WHEREAS, the SEMP Update aligns with several State policies including:
Senate Bill 32, a bill that requires GHG emissions be reduced to 40% below the

1990 levels by 2030; Executive Order B-55-18 mandating statewide carbon neutrality; and the Climate Emergency Declaration in 2019 declaring the urgency in protecting vulnerable communities; and

WHEREAS, the SEMP Update outlines a strategic roadmap for the County to reduce energy consumption and GHG emissions across its facilities while supporting the County's broader climate action goals; and

WHEREAS, recognizing the critical role of buildings in achieving these goals, the SEMP Update emphasizes a comprehensive and integrated approach; and

WHEREAS, the SEMP Update estimates that over the next 10 years (by 2035) \$361.7M will need to be spent on energy efficiency and building decarbonization projects to meet the GOCAP; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Works recommends this Board adopt the SEMP Update, which aligns with the County's climate action goals as stated in the and GOCAP and the State policies related to carbon emissions; and

WHEREAS, this Board has considered and concurs with the recommendation of the Director of Public Works.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that:

1. The October 2025 Strategic Energy Master Plan Update (SEMP Update), attached hereto as Exhibit A, be adopted.
2. The County and Department of Public Works are authorized to implement the recommendations in the SEMP Update to continue

efforts, work, and projects to decarbonize County facilities consistent with the 2020 Government Operations Climate Action Plan (GOCAP) by 2035.

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
