BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, COUNTY OF SAN MATEO, STATE OF CALIFORNIA

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RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH JOBTAIN TO PROVIDE PROGRAMS AND SERVICES TO SAN MATEO COUNTY'S INCARCERATED POPULATION, FOR THE TERM OF JULY 1, 2023 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2024, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$673,738

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, in March 2021, the County Executive's Office and the Sheriff's Office issued a joint Request for Proposals (RFP) for programs and services for the County's justice-involved population, reflecting the County's commitment to linking in-custody programs and services and out-of-custody service continuation; and

WHEREAS, JobTrain was selected from the joint RFP to provide Work Readiness, Success Coaching, Financial and Digital Literacy, ServSafe Certification, Culinary Arts and Hospitality, and Construction Pre-Apprenticeship program services to incarcerated individuals, thereby helping them to develop marketable skills and prepare them to enter the workforce upon release; and

WHEREAS, JobTrain is commencing year three of services to the justice-involved population; and

WHEREAS, there has been presented to this Board of Supervisors for its consideration and acceptance, an agreement with JobTrain for the term July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024 in an amount not to exceed \$673,738; and

WHEREAS, this Board has considered and approved this agreement as to both form and content and desires to enter into the agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized and directed to execute said agreement for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, and the Clerk of the Board shall attest the President's signature thereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Sheriff or Sheriff's designee is authorized to execute amendments to the agreement which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in aggregate per agreement), and/or modify the contract terms and/or services so long as the modified terms and/or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.

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
