RESOLUTION HONORING AND COMMENDING

*Nancy Magee*

Upon her retirement as

**San Mateo County Superintendent of Schools**

**WHEREAS, Nancy Magee** was first elected Superintendent of Schools for the County of San Mateo in 2018, leading the San Mateo County Office of Education (County Office), with a deep commitment to high quality and innovative instruction for every student, prioritizing investment in early learning, ensuring safe and supportive schools, and advancing environmental stewardship for California's youth; and

**WHEREAS, Nancy Magee** received a Master's degree in Library and Information Science from San Jose State University and a Bachelor's degree in English from San Diego State University, and embarked on a lifelong career in education and leadership, improving countless lives of students and families; and

**WHEREAS, Nancy Magee** worked in classrooms for over 20 years, and served in school district and County Office leadership roles for 11 years, including as the Associate Superintendent of Student Services at the County Office of Education; and

**WHEREAS, Nancy Magee**, served as chair of San Mateo County's Coalition for Safe Schools and Communities, through which she developed emergency response protocols, a suicide prevention toolkit, and a student threat assessment protocol that are the standard in the County's 23 school districts and modeled by school districts across the country; and

**WHEREAS, Nancy Magee** was a driving force behind the United for Youth Vision 2030 Blueprint, pursuing with the County's Behavioral Health and Recovery Services Division a countywide roadmap for providing youth mental health support and services; and

**WHEREAS, Nancy Magee** was on the leadership team for, and instrumental in, advancing The Big Lift, a countywide third-grade literacy initiative prioritizing early literacy to improve academic and lifelong outcomes; and

**WHEREAS, Nancy Magee** led the County Office through the challenges of the COVID-19 pandemic, supporting the transition to distance learning and back to in-person learning as safe conditions allowed, for which the San Mateo County School Boards Association recognized her with the Pillar of the County award, and the Association of California School Administrators (Region 5) named her Superintendent of the Year; and

**WHEREAS, Nancy Magee** served on the First 5 San Mateo County Commission, the Housing Endowment and Regional Trust (HEART) of San Mateo County, the Home for All – San Mateo County steering committee, and co-chaired the San Mateo County Child Care Partnership Council; and

**WHEREAS, Nancy Magee** provided visionary statewide leadership in empowering students to understand and seek solutions for climate change and advance sustainable communities, earning recognition, including the 2020 Sustainable San Mateo Sustainability Champion Award, a CA Green Ribbon Schools Gold Achiever Award, and securing a \$6 million grant from the California Legislature in 2021 for the County Office to develop climate change and environmental justice curriculum; and

**WHEREAS, under Nancy Magee's** exceptional leadership, the County Office was named "Medium County Office of the Year" by California County Superintendents in 2025; and

**WHEREAS, Nancy Magee** is a proud mom to two adult sons, Travis and Noah, and a devoted grandmother to two little girls, Avery and Emmy, who help inspire her commitment to creating a more sustainable world;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California hereby resolves that March 10<sup>th</sup> is recognized as **Nancy Magee Day** and honors and commends **Nancy Magee** for her steadfast and future-focused leadership on behalf of the students of San Mateo County over 31 years and wishes her joyous time with family upon her retirement as San Mateo County's Superintendent of Schools.
