AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF SAN MATEO AND VEOCI, INC.

Section 3 of the agreement is amended to read as follows:

In no event shall County's total fiscal obligation under this Agreement exceed TWO HUNDRED FIFTY-FOUR THOUSAND, ONE HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN DOLLARS (\$254,147).

2. Section 4 of the agreement is amended to read as follows:

The term of this Agreement shall be from December 15, 2022 through December 14, 2026.
