WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, pursuant to Government Code Section 31000, County may contract with independent contractors for the furnishing of such services to or for County or any Department thereof;

WHEREAS, the parties entered into an Agreement for the purpose of administering the Overflow Shelter Program (OSP) for Families and Inclement Weather services on June 30, 2020 in a total obligation amount not to exceed \$3,505,650 for the term of July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2023; and

WHEREAS, on May 23, 2023 the parties amended the Agreement to add \$3,635,875 in funds for a revised total obligation amount not to exceed \$7,141,525 and extend the term through June 30, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the parties now wish to amend the Agreement to add \$602,177 in funds for a revised total obligation amount not to exceed \$7,743,702 and update certain tables and contact information.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY AGREED BY THE PARTIES HERETO AS FOLLOWS:

1. Section 3. **Payments** of the Agreement is amended to read as follows:

In consideration of the services provided by Contractor in accordance with all terms, conditions, and specifications set forth in this Agreement and in Exhibit A, County shall make payment to Contractor based on the rates and in the manner specified in Exhibit B. County reserves the right to withhold payment if County determines that the quantity or quality of the work performed is unacceptable. In no event shall County's total fiscal obligation under this Agreement exceed **SEVEN MILLION SEVEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE THOUSAND, SEVEN HUNDRED AND TWO DOLLARS** (\$7,743,702). In the event that County makes any advance payments, Contractor agrees to refund any amounts in excess of the amount owed by County at the time of contract termination or expiration. Contractor is not entitled to payment for work not performed as required by this Agreement.
