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RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH LIFEMOVES FOR THE TERM OF JULY 1, 2025 TO JUNE 30, 2028, AND A TOTAL OBLIGATION AMOUNT OF \$780,000 TO PROVIDE MOTEL VOUCHERS AND SHELTER PROGRAM SERVICES

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the Human Services Agency's (HSA) Employment Services (ES) branch operates a Service Connect program which offers reentry and employment support services to justice-involved individuals to help them successfully reintegrate into the community and reduce recidivism; and

WHEREAS, Service Connect clients sometimes need emergency or temporary shelter which is critical to support their return to the community post-release because emergency housing gives these individuals an opportunity to reintegrate without recidivism; and

WHEREAS, in January 2025, HSA released a Request for Proposals (RFP) seeking a provider to administer a Service Connect Motel Voucher Program (MVP) with Shelter Services and LifeMoves was selected based on their experience, qualifications, and program approach as identified in the RFP evaluation criteria; and

WHEREAS, this has been presented to the Board of Supervisors, for its consideration an acceptance of an agreement with LifeMoves to provide motel vouchers

and shelter beds to formerly incarcerated individuals for a term of July 1, 2025 to June 30, 2028, with a total obligation amount of \$780,000; and

WHEREAS, the Board has been presented with a form of said agreement, has examined and approved it as to both form and content, and desires to enter into the agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the President of this Board of Supervisors is hereby authorized and directed to execute said agreement for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, and the Clerk of this Board shall attest the President's signature thereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Human Services Agency Director, or designee, is authorized to execute contract amendments which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in aggregate), and/or modify the contract term and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.

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
