**BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, COUNTY OF SAN MATEO, STATE OF CALIFORNIA**

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**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH CARDINAL HEALTH PHARMACY SERVICES, LLC TO PROVIDE REMOTE ORDER ENTRY PHARMACY SERVICES FOR THE TERM OF AUGUST 1, 2025 THROUGH JULY 31, 2028, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$468,000**

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**RESOLVED**, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

**WHEREAS**, in order for the San Mateo Medical Center (SMMC) to remain in compliance with was not in compliance with the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) conditions of participation, SMMC is required to have pharmacist review afterhours medication orders when SMMC pharmacy is closed prior to administration of a patient's first dose; and

**WHEREAS**, in June 2025, SMMC conducted a Request for Proposals (RFP) for a vendor to provide these services; and

**WHEREAS**, Cardinal Health Pharmacy Services, LLC (Cardinal) was elevated as the best fit vendor to provide remote order entry services at SMMC; and

**WHEREAS**, both parties wish to enter into an agreement to allow Cardinal to provide these services for the term of August 1, 2025 through July 31, 2028, in an amount not to exceed \$468,000; and

**WHEREAS**, this Board has been presented with a form of such agreement, has examined and approved it as both form and content, and desires to enter into the agreement.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED** that the President of the Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized and directed to execute said agreement for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, and the Clerk of the Board shall attest the President's signature thereto.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Chief of San Mateo County Health or designee is authorized to execute contract amendments which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in aggregate) and/or modify the contract term and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.

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
