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RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A "NO PARKING ANY TIME" ZONE ON CARLOS STREET FROM ETHELDORE/VALLEMAR STREET TO HIGHWAY 1 IN UNINCORPORATED MOSS BEACH

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, California Vehicle Code Section 22507, et seq., and Section 7.30.010 of the San Mateo County Ordinance Code allow this Board of Supervisors to prohibit or restrict the stopping, parking or standing of vehicles by resolution or ordinance authorizing installation of associated signs and markings; and

WHEREAS, Coastside Fire Protection District (CFPD) is the fire district with jurisdiction for City of Half Moon Bay and the unincorporated communities of Montara, Moss Beach, Princeton, El Granada, and Miramar in addition to the surrounding unincorporated areas; and

WHEREAS, CFPD Station 44 in Moss Beach is accessed via Carlos Street in unincorporated Moss Beach; and

WHEREAS, parking is not currently explicitly prohibited on Carlos Street and CFPD has found vehicles parked on the roadway shoulder, which can affect emergency access; and

WHEREAS, CFPD has indicated that restricting parking on Carlos Street is necessary to maintain emergency access; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Works has recommended that a "No Parking Any Time" zone be established as noted herein and on Attachment B to the memorandum accompanying this resolution; and

WHEREAS, this Board has reviewed and concurs with the recommendation of the Director of Public Works.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED as follows:

- A "No Parking Any Time" zone shall be established along Carlos Street within the unincorporated Moss Beach area at the following locations:
 - A) On the easterly side of Carlos Street commencing eighteen feet (18.0') north of the centerline of Etheldore Street / Vallemar Street, extending northerly a distance of approximately 2,640 feet.
 - B) On the westerly side of Carlos Street commencing eighteen feet (18.0') south of the centerline of Etheldore Street / Vallemar Street, extending northerly a distance of approximately 2,640 feet.
- The Department of Public Works is authorized and directed to post any necessary signs and pavement markings to effectuate this zone.
- The Director of Public Works or designee is authorized to take any other actions necessary to give effect to this resolution.

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
