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RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH SAMARITAN HOUSE FOR DIVERSION AND COORDINATED ENTRY SYSTEM SERVICES TO ADD \$299,000 IN FUNDS FOR A REVISED TOTAL OBLIGATION AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$ 3,113,849 AND THE TERM REMAINING JULY 1, 2021 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2024

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, on February 4, 2021 guided by the priorities of the County's Strategic Plan to End Homelessness, the Human Services Agency (HSA) released a Request for Proposals (RFP) for Diversion and Coordinated Entry System Services including Diversion Services to Prevent Individuals from Exiting Institutions into Homelessness for the San Mateo County Homeless System; and

WHEREAS, Samaritan House was selected as the provider that best meets the needs of San Mateo County; and

WHEREAS, on June 29, 2021 by Resolution No. 078284, this Board authorized an agreement with Samaritan House for the term of July 1, 2021 to June 30, 2024 for a total amount not to exceed \$2,721,457 to provide diversion and CES services to households experiencing homelessness; and

WHEREAS, on June 16, 2022 the agreement was amended to clarify that

diversion and CES services are available to individuals exiting institutions in San Mateo County with no change to the term or amount of the agreement; and

WHEREAS, on June 13, 2023 the agreement was amended to add \$93,392 to provide a cost-of-living adjustment; and

WHEREAS, there have been recent increases in the number of households accessing CES services via referrals from Homeless Outreach Teams and Core Service Agencies; and

WHEREAS, HSA wishes to amend this agreement to add \$299,000 in FY23-24 to provide additional funds for additional staff and limited financial assistance to meet the current increased need; and

WHEREAS, this Board has been presented with a form of such amendment, has examined, and approved it as to both form and content, and desires to enter it.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the President of this Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized and directed to execute said amendment for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, and the Clerk of the Board shall attest the President's signature thereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of the Human Services Agency or designee is authorized to execute contract amendments which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in the aggregate), and/or modify

the contract term and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.

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
