## RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE PESCADERO SOLID WASTE TRANSFER STATION GATE RATES

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the County owns the Pescadero Solid Waste Transfer Station that provides solid waste disposal and recycling options to the South Coastal area of San Mateo County; and

WHEREAS, on August 18, 2018, this Board adopted Resolution No. 076251, which approved an agreement with BFI Waste Systems of North America, LLC, DBA Allied Waste Services of San Mateo County (AWS) from August 18, 2018 through August 1, 2023; and

WHEREAS, on August 1, 2023 this Board adopted Resolution No. 079872, authorizing an amendment to the agreement with AWS, for the operation of the Pescadero Solid Waste Transfer Station for a maximum one-year term through August 30, 2024 for an amount not to exceed $\$ 300,000$ per fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, on January 26, 2016 this Board adopted Resolution No. 074302, which approved an increase in the Pescadero Solid Waste Transfer Station gate rates, effective on February 1, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the agreement with AWS states that the County shall have the exclusive authority to establish the gate rates and that such fees collected by AWS shall be the property of the County; and

WHEREAS, increasing the Pescadero Transfer Station Gate Rates Exhibit A will decrease the subsidy, while continuing to provide convenient solid waste disposal, reuse, and recycling opportunities to residents and the agricultural community of the South Coastal area of San Mateo County.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED as follows:
Effective January 15, 2024, the Pescadero Transfer Station Gate Rates are as set forth in Exhibit A to this Resolution, which is attached hereto and incorporated by reference.
