

**THIRD AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT
BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF SAN MATEO AND
FAMILY CONNECTIONS**

THIS THIRD AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT, entered into this date _____, by and between the COUNTY OF SAN MATEO, hereinafter called "County," and Family Connections, hereinafter called "Contractor";

W I T N E S S E T H:

WHEREAS, pursuant to Government Code Section 31000, County may contract with independent contractors for the furnishing of such services to or for County or any Department thereof;

WHEREAS, on October 17, 2023, by Resolution No. 080004, the parties entered into an agreement ("Agreement") for a term of October 1, 2023 to June 30, 2026, for a total obligation amount not to exceed \$989,855, for the purpose of providing child abuse prevention services to include early childhood education, parent education, home visitation and behavioral health services; and

WHEREAS, the Human Services Agency received supplemental funding under the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 for the Community Based Child Abuse Prevention (ARPA CBCAP) program in the amount of \$65,000 to support child abuse prevention activities; and

WHEREAS, on December 2, 2025, by Resolution No. R081538, the parties amended the Agreement ("First Amendment") to increase funding by \$65,000 for a new total obligation amount of \$1,054,855, with no change to the term, to cover the cost to provide additional services and reporting related to the additional ARPA CBCAP funding; and

WHEREAS, on May 7, 2026, the parties amended the Agreement ("Second Amendment") to increase the term by 2 years, for a new term of October 1, 2023 to June 30, 2028, and the total obligation amount remained \$1,054,855 to continue services for the additional term; and

WHEREAS, the parties wish to further amend the Agreement ("Third Amendment") to increase the total value by \$747,100 for a new total obligation amount of \$1,801,955, with no change to the term, to cover the cost to continue services for the additional term added under the Second Amendment.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY AGREED BY THE PARTIES HERETO AS FOLLOWS:

1. Section 3. **Payments** is hereby amended to read as follows:

In consideration of the services provided by Contractor in accordance with all terms, conditions, and specifications set forth in this Agreement and in Exhibits A, A1, C and Attachments D, F, H, I and P County shall make payment to Contractor based on the rates and in the manner specified in Exhibit B. County reserves the right to withhold payment if County determines that the quantity or quality of the work performed is unacceptable. In no event shall County's total fiscal obligation under this Agreement exceed **ONE MILLION EIGHT HUNDRED ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$1,801,955)**. In the event that the County makes any advance payments, Contractor agrees to refund any amounts in excess of the amount owed by the County at the time of contract termination or expiration. Contractor is not entitled to payment for work not performed as required by this agreement.

2. Exhibit B1 – Budgets is hereby amended to include budgets for FY2026-27 and FY 2027-28 budgets and are attached hereto.
3. Exhibit C - Performance and Reporting Paragraph IV (Performance Outcomes/Measures) is hereby amended to provide that the measures and outcomes set forth in the table for FY 2025–26 shall apply to FY 2026-27 and FY 2027-28.
4. All other terms and conditions of the agreement dated October 17 2023, and its subsequent First and Second Amendments, between the County and Contractor shall remain in full force and effect.
